STAYING SAFE

We are delighted to be planning for an unrestricted Championships this summer, however, your safety and that of all our guests remains our top priority. We ask that you remain considerate of your fellow guests to help reduce the spread of infectious diseases such as COVID-19.



Stay home if you are symptomatic or have tested positive for COVID-19.

In line with our ticket policy, full refunds are available if the Ticket Office is notified by calling 020 8944 1066 or emailing <u>ticketing@aeltc.com</u> at least 24 hours before you are due to attend.



In line with UK government guidelines, COVID passes are not required for entry.



- Please bring your fully charged mobile phone with the latest version of the Wimbledon App installed and your ticket downloaded.
- You will be required to show photo ID along with your ticket.

Your ticket guarantees you entry to the Grounds on the date shown and, if applicable, to the court and seat on your ticket. Your ticket does not guarantee that you will be able to watch any particular match, round of matches or individual players. Scheduling requirements may mean that matches occasionally move from one court to another.



TICKET CONDITIONS

Tickets are issued subject to the <u>AELTC's</u> <u>Terms and Conditions of Sale</u> (the "Terms and Conditions"). Please refer to the full Terms and Conditions, but your attention is particularly drawn to the following clauses: 13 (Use of Tickets), 17 (Refunds), 18 (Curtailment of Play), 19 (Liability) and 20 (Force Majeure).

Except as expressly permitted in clause 13.2 of the Terms and Conditions, any resale, transfer of ticket(s), offer or advertisement of ticket(s) for resale or transfer, whether for free or for consideration, is strictly prohibited.


Tickets with the word 'DEBENTURE' marked on them in place of the price may be legally transferred or sold on. Do not buy tickets from touts or other unauthorised agents; they will not gain you entry to the Grounds.

REFUND/NON-TRANSFER POLICY

If you cannot use your tickets, please request a refund at <u>ticketing@aeltc.com</u>. If you purchased your tickets through the LTA, please contact the LTA Customer Support Team to request a refund through their <u>online form</u>, making sure you include your order number. Tickets are strictly nontransferable and you will not be able to give the mobile ticket to anyone else apart from your guest.

SOCIAL MEDIA -NO TICKET PHOTOS!

We know that you will be looking forward to your visit to Wimbledon, but please do not post pictures of your ticket offer or tickets on any social media or websites. People may use the details to defraud or attempt to defraud third parties into buying them.





CURTAILMENT OF PLAY

If there is a curtailment of play, you may be entitled to a refund of some, or all, of your ticket price. The amount refunded will depend on the Referee's record of how much play takes place on your ticketed court. Please refer to the Terms and Conditions (and in particular clause 18) for more information.

CHILDREN

A day at Wimbledon is an exciting and memorable experience. Please read the following if you are thinking of bringing young people with you:

- The Grounds are large and crowded so we don't recommend bringing babies.
- A ticket is not required for those under five, however children under five are not allowed into the Show Courts (Centre, No.1, No.2, No.3, Court 12, Court 18).
- Children over five and under 16 are welcome, provided they are accompanied by an adult at all times and have their own seat.



Toilets

There are many accessible toilets around the Grounds, as well as two Changing Places toilets – see the <u>**Grounds map**</u> for locations.

To use our accessible toilets, you will need a RADAR key. These are available free of charge from every entrance gate or our Information Desks.

Wheelchair & Mobility Aids

We have designated areas to leave your mobility scooter or wheelchair. See the <u>map</u> for locations. Please note that neither the AELTC nor St John Ambulance provide wheelchairs for visitors.

Court Seating for Wheelchair Users

Centre Court, No.1 Court, No.2 Court and No.3 Court have reserved wheelchair seating for ticket holders; there are also unreserved spaces available for wheelchair users on all outside courts.

Sunflower Lanyard

At Wimbledon we understand that not all disabilities are visible, and our staff recognise that those wearing a sunflower lanyard may need additional assistance or support during their visit. Sunflower lanyards are available from the gates and Ticket Resolution points.

TRAVEL

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Please use the TfL Journey Planner to choose the best mode of transport.



Southfields Station (District Line) a 20 minute walk to the Grounds.

 Wimbledon Station (District Line / South Western Railway / London Trams) a 25 minute walk to the Grounds. Please be aware this route involves a steep hill.

 Wimbledon Park Station (District Line) a 25 minute walk to the Grounds.

There is a dedicated Championships bus service from Wimbledon station to and from the Grounds during the event. Single fare £3.50, return fare £5. Return buses leave from outside Gate 11 on Somerset Road (exit the Grounds through Gates 12 or 13). Please note the 493 TfL bus service does not stop outside the Grounds during The Championships.

CYCLING

Bicycle parking is situated in Car Park 6 and is free of charge. Bicycles are left at owner's risk.

PARKING

- Reserved parking is available via The AA in advance in Car Parks 6 and 10 - £30. Book here.
- Pay on the day, subject to availability, in Car Parks 6 and 10 - £35.
- Motorcycles Car Park 4 £10.

- Please note, a section of Church Road between Gate 1 and Gate 5 will be closed from 9.00am-11.30pm during The Championships.
- Please follow signed routes to car parks, rather than sat nav in order to avoid delays.

PARK & RIDE

A Championships Park & Ride service is available at Morden Park (located on the A24, postcode SM4 5QU) charged at £15 per car and £20 for minibuses. This is open from 6.30am until 11pm, with the last bus leaving the AELTC at 10pm, or at 10.40pm if there is late play on Centre or No.1 Courts.

TAXIS

Taxi ranks are situated at Southfields and Wimbledon stations, and on Church Road (across from Gate 4, situated on Wimbledon Park Golf Course) and Somerset Road (Gate 12). See our designated drop-off and pickup areas for pre-booked taxi services on the Walkers map.

ARRIVAL AT THE GATES

- You may be given a specific entry time in advance of your attendance, so please check your email before you travel to the Grounds.
- On arrival at the Gate please have your ticket ready to be scanned along with accompanying photo ID.
- Please be prepared to have your bag searched on entry to the Grounds.
- You will not be permitted to take in any prohibited items.





AT THE CHAMPIONSHIPS

WATCHING TENNIS

We remind all guests:

- To switch phones/tablets to silent, and to ensure that the flash is turned off.
- There are no supporting rails in tiered sections of the stands, and that they should be particularly careful in these areas.
- You should only enter or leave a court at the change of ends or between matches, not during play.
- Not to make any noise during a rally.
- To applaud the players, but not to clap a net cord or double fault.
- Not to bring glass drinking vessels and uncorked bottles into the stands on court.

NEW FOR 2022

This is a very special year for The Championships as we celebrate the centenary of our move from Worple Road to Church Road and the opening of Centre Court.

Whilst reflecting on the past, this is also an opportunity to envisage what is to come in the next 100 years and we are pleased to share with you some of the changes in place this year.

Middle Sunday

Middle Sunday (Sunday 3 July) will not only feature as a permanent part of The Championships schedule for the first time, but will also be the focal point for the Centre Court centenary celebrations, with a special moment planned at 1.30pm to honour many of the historic feats witnessed on this iconic stage of world sport. It will also be a day for the local community, with tickets distributed to local residents, schools, charities and community groups.

Platinum Jubilee

To mark Her Majesty The Queen's Platinum Jubilee, the Finals Weekend coin tosses will feature two bespoke platinum coins, donated by the World Platinum Investment Council.

Ticketing

After a two-year absence, the Queue will return for spectators wishing to buy tickets on the day, as will Ticket Resale, for those wishing to purchase returned Centre Court, No.1 Court and No.2 Court tickets, with all proceeds (net of VAT) going to the Wimbledon Foundation.

On the Court

A final set tie-break, with the first to 10 points with a two-point advantage at 6-6 in the final set will be introduced this year, apart from Juniors and Wheelchair events, achieving consistency with the other Grand Slams.

The Quad Wheelchair draws have been doubled, to eight singles and four doubles and our Junior Championships expands with the addition of the 14&U draw alongside our existing 18&U draw, giving the world's best juniors the opportunity to compete on grass at an earlier age.

The Centre Court bowl has received a refresh, with a new central entrance for the players walking on court.

The umpire's chair has been redesigned and will be in situ on Centre Court and No.1 Court this year. The umpires and linespeople will be dressed in new uniforms, delivered in partnership with Ralph Lauren, Official Outfitter of The Championships.





ENVIRONMENT POSITIVE EVERY DAY: LET'S MAKE A DIFFERENCE TOGETHER

At Wimbledon, we know we have a responsibility to protect and preserve the environment we all depend on. It's important to us and we know it matters to you too.

What is the AELTC doing?

Environment Positive is our sustainability aim and a mindset we want to adopt, so that over time all actions we take are guided with Environment Positive in mind.

Reusable Cups

We have a deposit scheme in place for hot and cold drinks, now sold in reusable cups which can be used on site again and again, year after year.



PLEASE NOTE

You can collect your deposit from any drinks outlet with the exception of Pimm's on the Tea Lawn and any Sweets & Treats kiosk

The Charity Return Points are located throughout the Grounds, with the full £1 deposit being donated to the Wimbledon Foundation. Please return your cup so it can be used again and again.



Recycling

None of our waste goes to landfill. Our aim is:



To reduce the amount of waste generated

To increase the amount we reuse

To recycle as much remaining material as possible

Recycling bins are provided throughout the Grounds and Queue and are clearly labelled.



What Can I Recycle?



Plastic

e.g. empty plastic containers/ bottles, plastic bags



Paper and card

e.g. paper bags, clean dry card, clean food containers



Glass e.g. empty bottles

This year, **Evian**, the Official Water Partner of Wimbledon, is introducing an incentive scheme to further encourage recycling across the Grounds. Guests may scan the QR code on the dry mixed recycling bin and then scan the bar code on the item they are recycling. They will then have a chance to win Show Court tickets for The Championships 2023.

Official Coffee of The Championships, **Lavazza**, will once again serve a sustainable experience for guests from its activation areas at The Hill and Centenary Gardens with a no-waste edible Cookie Cup.

General waste is for everything else e.g. dirty food containers, cutlery, napkins, crisp packets. If in doubt, use general waste to avoid contamination of recycling.

Food waste is collected from kitchens and used to generate energy and fertiliser. Coffee grounds are used by our gardeners around the Grounds.

THE WIMBLEDON FOUNDATION

The Wimbledon Foundation is the charity of The All England Lawn Tennis Club and The Championships.

During The Championships, the Foundation will be running activities from the Foundation Kiosk adjacent to Court 15 including Explore Wimbledon, an activity booklet for children. WaterAid will be showcasing the partnership with the Wimbledon Foundation in the Queue.

The Wimbledon Foundation has been active in supporting the Ukraine crisis response. A donation of £100,000 was made to the British Red Cross Ukraine Crisis Appeal; £50,000 to the DEC's Ukraine Humanitarian Appeal; and locally, £20,000 to the Association for Polish Family, an existing charity partner, that has been collecting essentials to support the tens of thousands of Ukrainians crossing the Polish border.

The Foundation also invited local residents to nominate an inspirational young person from the boroughs of Merton or Wandsworth to perform the pre-match coin toss at this year's ladies' and gentlemen's singles finals.

HSBC has proudly supported the scheme since 2008, supporting local causes in an extensive programme of community and charitable activities administered by the Wimbledon Foundation. During the course of the Wimbledon & HSBC partnership, Ticket Resale has raised £3.79m, including £1.89m from HSBC.

Despite the absence of the traditional Ticket Resale Scheme at The Championships 2021, HSBC continued its financial support and ensured that many of the charities that benefit from the Ticket Resale Scheme still received a donation - such as Give It Your Max, The Dan Maskell Trust and Tennis First.

LOOKING TO THE FUTURE

Investing for the future remains a key priority for us and we continue to focus on enhancing the experience of The Championships for our stakeholders and providing benefit to our local community.

The AELTC Wimbledon Park Project


We submitted our planning application last summer for the AELTC Wimbledon Park Project and anticipate a Planning Committee date to be confirmed in the coming weeks.




First Aid & Pharmacy

Left Luggage

We have three left luggage locations:

- Wimbledon Park, servicing the Queue, open from 5.30am
- AELTC Wimbledon Park, open from 7.30am
- Somerset Road, open from 9am

All left luggage locations close one hour after the end of play.

Items are charged at £1 each for all bags and £5 for larger items.

Please note that bags deposited should be no bigger than $60 \text{ cm} \times 45 \text{ cm} \times 25 \text{ cm}/24$ " x 18" x 10" (aircraft cabin size). All bags will be searched before acceptance into left luggage facilities.


Pass-Outs

Ticket Resale

Subject to availability, after 3pm you may purchase returned Show Court tickets from the Ticket Resale Kiosk north of Court 18 adjacent to The Hill. Tickets cost £15 for Centre Court and £10 for No.1 Court and No.2 Court. All proceeds (net of VAT) go to the Wimbledon Foundation.



Water Refills

Please keep hydrated and refill your bottle for free at refill points throughout the Grounds.



Wi-Fi

Free Wi-Fi is available on The Hill and along the east side of the Grounds including Parkside and the Tea Lawn.



Wimbledon Lawn Tennis Museum






Please plan your journey home carefully as stations and roads get very busy at the end of play.

BEFORE YOU VISIT

- Pack everything you need in a bag measuring no more than 40cm x 30cm x 30cm.
- Familiarise yourself with the list of items that aren't allowed inside the Grounds <u>here</u>.

Emergency

In the event of an emergency, please either:

- Contact a member of staff or steward/guard immediately
- Or call using a red emergency telephone or dial 020 8971 2666 from an external line.

Give your name, the nature of the incident and the location.

Evacuation

If you are asked to evacuate a court or the Grounds, please leave by the nearest suitable exit or as directed by uniformed stewarding staff, taking all your personal belongings with you.

Security

We work closely with the Metropolitan Police to ensure the safety of everyone in our Grounds. To achieve this, security measures are in place at all times; at your point of entry we will search both you and your bags.

Bags are restricted to one per person and must be no larger than 40cm x 30cm x 30cm or 16" x 12" x 12". Please bear in mind that it takes longer to search multipocketed bags/backpacks.
