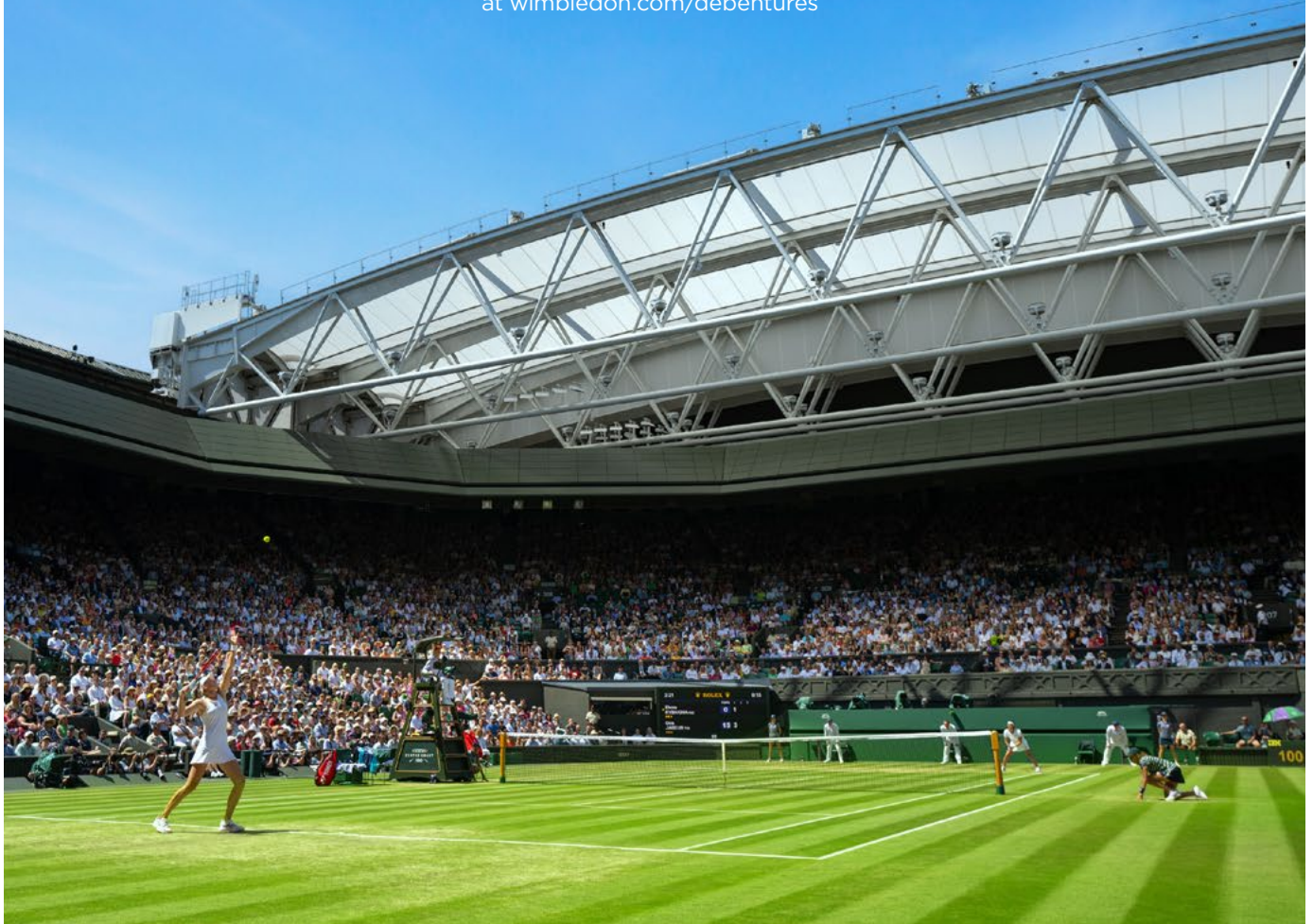

BEFORE YOU VISIT

IS THERE A DRESS CODE?

Many of our guests choose to dress up for a day at Wimbledon, although there is no requirement for men to wear a jacket or tie in the debenture restaurants.

Please ensure you dress comfortably and are prepared for the British weather, whether that be rain or very warm sunshine.

WHAT SIZE BAG CAN I BRING WITH ME?

Bags must be no larger than 40cm x 30cm x 30cm.

If you have luggage that is larger than this, it will need to be stored at one of our three left luggage locations, outside of the main Grounds. Find out more [here](#).

- 10am ○ The Grounds and debenture areas open daily
- 11am ○ Play begins on outside courts
- 1pm ○ Play begins on No.1 Court (apart from Finals weekend when play starts at 11am)
- 1.30pm ○ Play begins on Centre Court (apart from Finals weekend when play starts at 2pm)

The Terrace in Centre Court and the No.1 Lounge in No.1 Court will remain open serving hot, light bites until 9pm.

Please note the actual closing times for the restaurants and bars may vary depending on when play finishes.





WHICH GATE SHOULD I ARRIVE AT?

All debenture ticket holders are encouraged to use Gate 4 on Church Road.

WHAT DO I HAVE ACCESS TO WITH MY DEBENTURE TICKET?

Debenture tickets are for the court specified on the date shown and entitle the ticket holder to entrance to that court and not to view a particular match, round of matches or individual players. Matches may move from one court to another at the discretion of the AELTC. See full terms and conditions [here](#).

You may also watch matches on any court throughout the Grounds with unreserved seating.

To watch your favourite players practising, visit the viewing platform next to the Practice Courts in **Aorangi**.

Centre Court debenture ticket holders also have access to the Centre Court debenture bars and restaurants and The Renshaw restaurant located in No.1 Court (by reservation only).

No.1 Court debenture ticket holders also have access to the No.1 Court debenture bars and restaurants.

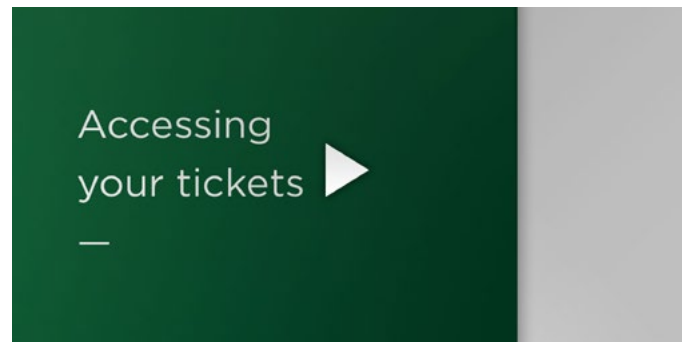
DO YOU TAKE CASH?

This is a cashless event, so please bring your credit/debit card or other form of cashless payment.

YOUR TICKETS

- Have your mobile ticket ready in the Wimbledon App along with photo ID for entry.
- The QR code on your mobile ticket will be active from 7am on the morning of the day you are attending.

HOW DO I ACCESS MY TICKET ON MY PHONE?



WHERE DO I GO IF I HAVE ISSUES WITH MY TICKET UPON ARRIVAL?

Please head to the Ticket Resolution Point at Gate 3 on Church Road if you have any issues with your debenture tickets.

WHERE ARE MY SEATS?

Debenture seats are located in rows A-N on Centre Court and rows A-Q on No.1 Court.

Your seat details will include a seat number, a row and a gangway. The gangway denotes the stairwell that you need to use to enter the court.

CAN I BRING CHILDREN?

Children over five and under 16 are welcome, provided they are always accompanied by an adult and have their own seat ticket.

Whilst we don't recommend bringing babies and infants, a ticket is not required for those under five. However, children under five are not allowed into the Show Courts (Centre Court, No.1 Court, No.2 Court, No.3 Court, Court 12, Court 18).



TRAVEL


The main road outside the Grounds, Church Road, remains partially closed for the duration of The Championships to enhance the arrival experience for all our guests.


PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Please allow plenty of time to reach the Grounds. Public transport and roads around the Grounds may be heavily congested. Access the TfL Journey Planner [here](#).

 **Southfields Station** (District Line) - a 15 minute walk to the Grounds.

 Taxis for the Grounds depart from the rank in Augustus Road adjacent to the station and drop off inside Car Park 8.

 **Wimbledon Station** (District Line/South Western Railway/London Trams) - a 20 minute walk to the Grounds.

 Taxis drop off at the bottom of Marrayat Road close to Gates 12 and 13.

 **Wimbledon Park Station** (District Line) - a 25 minute walk to the Grounds.

 A dedicated Championships bus service runs from Wimbledon Station to and from the Grounds. Single fare £3.80, return fare £5.90. Return buses leave from outside Gate 11a on Somerset Road.

Please note the 493 TfL bus service does not stop outside the Grounds during The Championships.

RIDE-SHARING APPS DROP OFF

Ride-sharing apps must use the designated drop-off areas located on Marrayat Road and Victoria Road. Please note that Uber or Bolt cars etc cannot pass through the Church Road closure.





PRIVATE TAXI OR CHAUFFEUR CAR DROP OFF

- In the morning all private taxis and chauffeur cars should approach the site from the south (from Wimbledon).
- Please request a digital Temporary Access Pass from the AA in advance to gain access through the road closure for drop off at the Guest Arrival Hub in Car Park 5.
- This will be emailed to you and must be shown on arrival to allow the vehicle past the road closure and directly to the Guest Arrival Hub in Car Park 5.
- Please note this pass does not entitle the holder to park. Once drop-off has taken place, the driver must exit by Car Park 8, north on to Church Road.

MOBILITY ASSISTANCE DROP OFF

A drop-off point is available opposite Gate 13 on Somerset Road for blue badge holders.

If you would like to be dropped off nearer the debenture entrance at Gate 4, please request a Temporary Access Pass (as above). You can then use the buggy shuttle service operating from Car Park 5 to transport you to Gate 4.

CAR SERVICE

Gerrard Cars offers a service for debenture holders who wish to arrange transport to and from The Championships.

The drop-off and pick-up location is at the Guest Arrival Hub in Car Park 5.





PARKING AT THE GROUNDS

- Car Park 5 is available for registered debenture holders.
- Car Park 6 is available for all ticket holders and can be pre-booked.
- Minibus parking is available in Car Parks 1 and 6.
- Motorcycle parking is available in Car Park 6.

Bookings can be made in the run up to, and throughout The Championships, by calling the AA Wimbledon Parking booking line on **0330 041 3677**. Booking lines are open Monday to Friday 9am - 5pm until 30 June and then from 8am - 6pm every day during The Championships.

Due to the temporary closure of Church Road, please follow the signposted routes that correspond to the colour of your parking pass rather than relying on sat nav directions. Car Parks 5 and 6 have red passes.

BLUE BADGE PARKING

- An area within Car Park 5 is available for registered debenture holders with blue badges.
- An area within Car Park 6 is available for all other blue badge holders.

ACCESSING THE GROUNDS FROM THE CAR PARKS

There is a very short walk from Car Park 5, which takes you past the Guest Arrival Hub, for use by debenture and hospitality ticket holders, then across Church Road to Gate 4.

From Car Park 6 follow the signs to Church Road, then to Gate 4.

LEAVING THE GROUNDS

Quickest exit point to walk to Wimbledon and head south

Please exit via Gates 12 and 13 for a shuttle bus to Wimbledon Station.

Quickest exit point to walk to Southfields and head to Central London

Please leave via Gates 1, 4 or 5 for a 20 minute walk to Southfields Station.

Ride-sharing taxis pick-up

The pick-up points are located on Marrayat Road and Victoria Road. Please note that Uber and Bolt cars etc cannot pass through the Church Road closure.

Taxi pick-up

Please exit via Gate 12 for taxis to Wimbledon and the south.

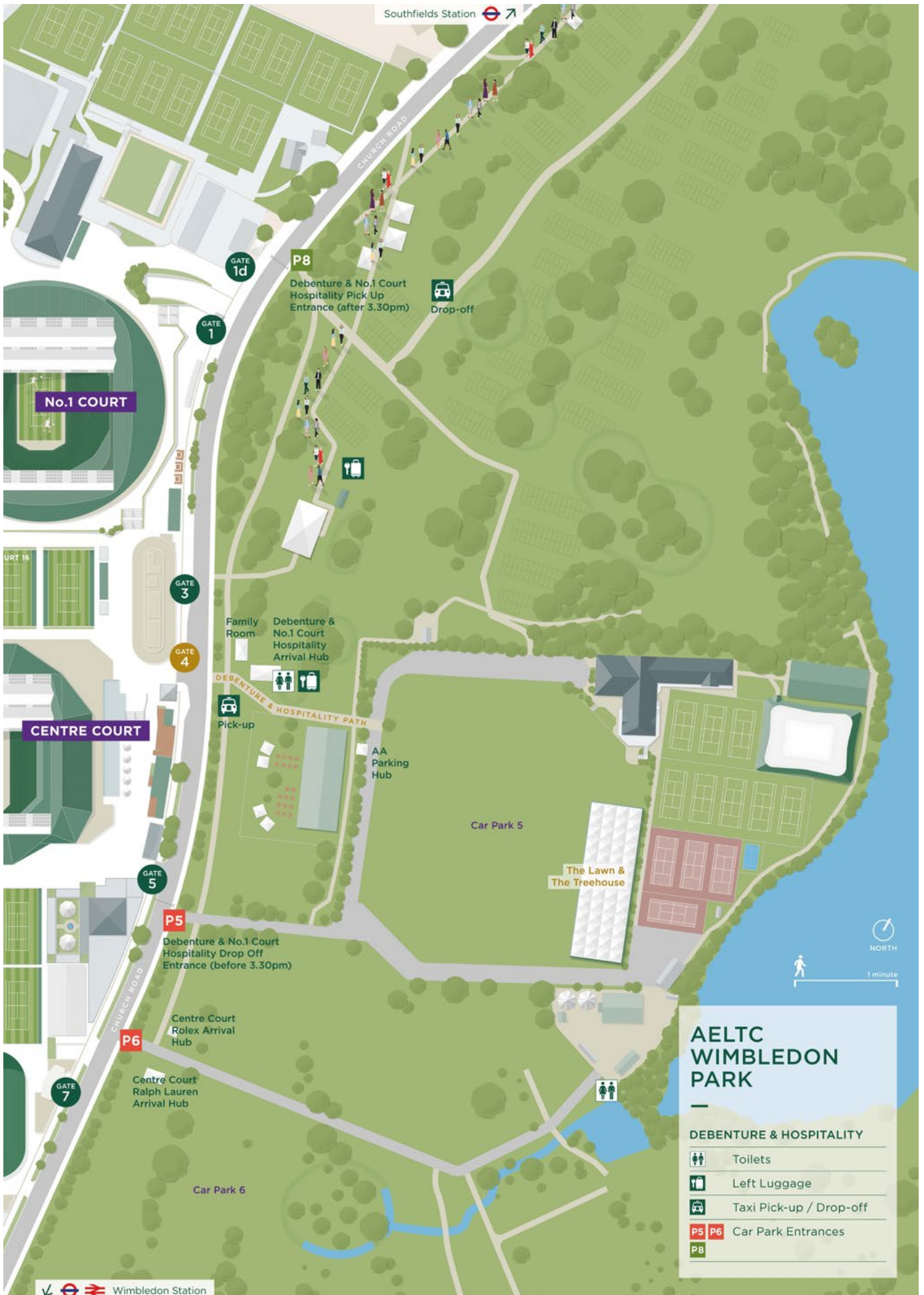
Please exit via Gate 4 for taxis to Southfields and Central London. Walk across Church Road and the taxi rank is situated to the right of the Guest Arrival Hub.

Private taxis or chauffeur pick-up

- The pick-up point is the Guest Arrival Hub at Car Park 5.
- Please make your way to the Guest Arrival Hub, opposite Gate 4, to wait for your private taxi or chauffeur car.
- **Please note**, collection access to Car Park 5 for private taxis and chauffeur cars opens from 3.30pm and access is via the entrance to Car Park 8 on Church Road, from the north. Drivers will need to display their Temporary Access Pass to gain entry.

AT THE CHAMPIONSHIPS

CAN I MEET FRIENDS OR FAMILY BEFORE ENTERING THE GROUNDS?

There is a Guest Arrival Hub for the use of debenture and hospitality ticket holders, which offers seating, light refreshments and toilets. It is a great place to wait for guests who are joining you for the day.

Debenture Hosts will be available here to answer any questions you may have.

The Guest Arrival Hub is located through the walkway opposite Gate 4, which is the gate we encourage all debenture ticket holders to use to enter the Grounds. View the map [here](#).



ONCE IN THE GROUNDS HOW DO I ACCESS THE DEBENTURE AREAS?

To gain access to the debenture areas within Centre Court and No.1 Court, please show your mobile ticket. Debenture information lanyards will be provided at the entry points to the facilities upon displaying your ticket. Spot checks of mobile tickets will remain in place throughout the day.

WHERE CAN I FIND INFORMATION ONCE I'M IN THE GROUNDS?

Our team of Debenture Hosts, dressed in Ralph Lauren uniforms and wearing name badges, will be on hand to assist you throughout the day.

Hosts are located at the Debenture Information Point to the left of the Fred Perry statue, which is visible once you enter Gate 4, and throughout the debenture areas. The Debenture Information Point is open from 10am – 2pm each day.





ARE THERE CLOAKROOMS IN THE DEBENTURE AREAS?

- The Centre Court cloakroom is located inside the ground floor Fred Perry entrance.
- The No.1 Court cloakrooms are located inside the ground floor of The Renshaw restaurant and at the debenture reception next to The Veranda restaurant entrance.
- Please bring any items you need with you in a bag measuring no more than 40cm x 30cm x 30cm.

NEW FOR 2023

Each year we strive to improve the experience on offer at The Championships for all our guests. There are several changes in place around the Grounds this year. These include:

On Court

In discussion around how best to support women and girls competing at The Championships we have changed our white

clothing rule. Female competitors are now able to wear mid/dark-coloured undershorts if they choose to do so.

The Gentlemen's Doubles format has been shortened from best-of-five sets to best-of-three bringing Wimbledon into line with the other Grand Slams.

Alongside the other Grand Slams and the Tours, Wimbledon will participate in a one-year trial of off-court coaching.





Environmental Sustainability

Our commitment to becoming Environment Positive by 2030 remains in sight and we have introduced a number of initiatives this year to help us reach this goal. The most noticeable Environment Positive change will be on court. Working alongside evian, our Official Partner for the last 15 years, we are pleased to confirm the next step in our sustainability journey together is the pilot of an on-court refillable water solution, which will offer pure evian water for the players. We will be providing players with reusable bottles that they can refill during their time at The Championships.

Throughout the Grounds, all our food menus will highlight the low CO2 dishes available, with emissions below 500g per portion. A QR code provides a link to more detail for guests seeking further information.

We want to make it easier for our guests to make informed choices when they visit Wimbledon, all the while tracking and reducing emissions associated with the food we prepare and serve.

Southern Village

A series of enhancements have been made in the Southern Village - the section of the Grounds running between No.2 Court and the Rosewater Pavilion.

These include a large screen set up showing live tennis with deck chairs, weather shade and an improved food and drink offering alongside our exciting **partner activation** spaces.

A new entry gate (Gate 11a) will be opened in this space to ease the flow of guests into the Grounds.

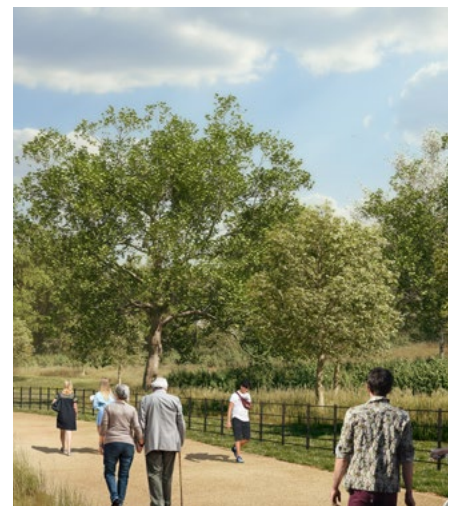

Debenture tickets provide you with access to a seat on Centre Court or No.1 Court, and the debenture areas.

There are a range of restaurants and bars available to enjoy a variety of food and drink from within the Centre Court and No.1 Court debenture areas.

CAN I MAKE A RESTAURANT RESERVATION?

Advance reservations for our fine dining restaurants, The Champions' Room, The Courtside Restaurant and The Renshaw (at No.1 Court) can only be made by registered debenture holders.

There may be some last-minute availability on the day, so please speak with the team at the Debenture Information Point next to the Fred Perry statue upon arrival.



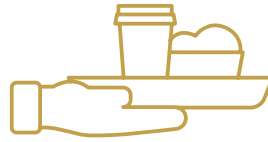

You will be able to see matches played on Courts 14 - 17 from a number of the restaurants and bars, however you are not able to view play on Centre Court or No.1 Court from them.

- Please access the restaurant via The Renshaw entrance located near to Courts 15 and 16.
- Please provide your booking name to our host team upon arrival at the restaurant entrance.

What is included?

- Your table is reserved for the day and includes a welcome glass of Pimm's No.1 cup or Lanson Black Label Brut NV, a three-course lunch and traditional Wimbledon afternoon tea.

What time does my experience begin?

- There is often plenty of availability for afternoon tea, and walk-ins are accepted.
- If you have a lunch reservation and would like to return for afternoon tea, we are unable to guarantee that we can seat you in the same location.

- The Courtside Restaurant offers a three-course fixed price lunch menu.
