# BEFORE YOU VISIT

## IS THERE A DRESS CODE?

Many of our guests choose to dress up for a day at Wimbledon, although there is no requirement for men to wear a jacket or tie in the debenture restaurants.

Please ensure you dress comfortably and are prepared for the British weather, whether that be rain or very warm sunshine.

## WHAT SIZE BAG CAN I BRING WITH ME?

Pack everything you need in one bag per person measuring no larger than 40cm x 30cm x 30cm.

If your luggage is larger than this, it will need to be stored at one of our three left luggage locations, outside the main Grounds. Find out more [here](#).

## TIMINGS

- 10am** The Grounds and debenture areas open daily
- 11am** Play begins on outside courts
- 1pm** Play begins on No.1 Court (apart from Finals weekend when play starts at 11am)
- 1.30pm** Play begins on Centre Court (apart from Finals weekend when play starts at 2pm)

Visit [wimbledon.com](http://wimbledon.com) for the Order of Play.

The Terrace in Centre Court and the No.1 Lounge in No.1 Court will remain open serving hot, light bites until 9pm.

Please note the actual closing times for the restaurants and bars may vary depending on when play finishes.





## WHICH GATE SHOULD I ARRIVE AT?

All debenture ticket holders are encouraged to use Gate 4 on Church Road.

## WHAT DO I HAVE ACCESS TO WITH MY DEBENTURE TICKET?

Debenture tickets are for the court specified on the date shown and entitle the ticket holder to entrance to that court and not to view a particular match, round of matches or individual players. Matches may move from one court to another at the discretion of the AELTC. See full terms and conditions [here](#).

You may also watch matches on any court throughout the Grounds with unreserved seating.

To watch your favourite players practising, visit the viewing platform next to the practice courts in **Aorangi**.

Centre Court debenture ticket holders also have access to the Centre Court debenture bars and restaurants and The Renshaw restaurant located in No.1 Court (by reservation only).

No.1 Court debenture ticket holders also have access to the No.1 Court debenture bars and restaurants.

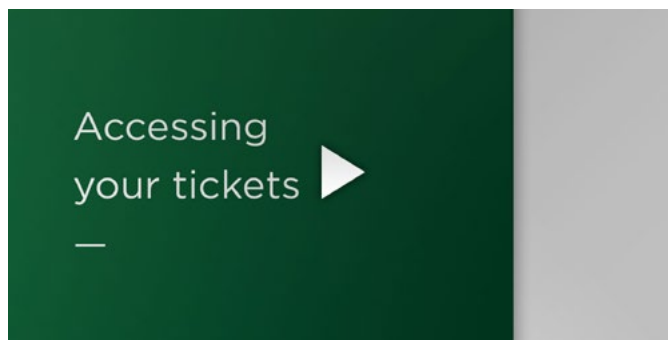
## DO YOU TAKE CASH?

This is a cashless event, so please bring your credit/debit card or other form of cashless payment.

## YOUR TICKETS

- Have your mobile ticket ready in the Wimbledon App along with photo ID for entry.
- The QR code on your mobile ticket will be active from 7am on the morning of the day you are attending.

## WHERE DO I GO IF I HAVE ISSUES WITH MY TICKET UPON ARRIVAL?

Please head to the Ticket Resolution Point at Gate 3 on Church Road if you have any issues with your debenture tickets.

## WHERE ARE MY SEATS?

Debenture seats are located in rows A-N on Centre Court and rows A-Q on No.1 Court.

Your seat details will include a seat number, a row and a gangway. The gangway denotes the stairwell that you need to use to enter the court.

## CAN I BRING CHILDREN?

Children over five and under 16 are welcome, provided they are always accompanied by an adult and have their own seat ticket.

Whilst we don't recommend bringing babies and infants, a ticket is not required for those under five. However, children under five are not allowed into the Show Courts (Centre Court, No.1 Court, No.2 Court, No.3 Court, Court 12 and Court 18).






# TRAVEL


The main road outside the Grounds, Church Road, remains partially closed for the duration of The Championships to enhance the arrival experience for all our guests.


## PUBLIC TRANSPORT

**The Championships Journey Planner** is the best way to plan your trip. The planner highlights the most sustainable options for travelling to and from Wimbledon.

 **Southfields Station** (District Line)  
- 15 minute walk to the Grounds.

 Taxis for the Grounds depart from the rank in Augustus Road adjacent to the station and drop off inside Car Park 8.

 **Wimbledon Station** (District Line/South Western Railway/London Trams)  
- 20 minute walk to the Grounds.

 Taxis drop off at Marryat Road, near the intersection with Somerset Road, close to Gates 12 and 13.

 **Wimbledon Park Station** (District Line)  
- 25 minute walk to the Grounds.

 A dedicated Championships bus service runs from Wimbledon Station to the Grounds.

- Single fare £4.00
- Return fare £6.00

Return buses leave from Car Park 1 on Somerset Road.

Please note that the 493 TfL bus service is redirected during The Championships via Bathgate Road, Queensmere Road, Parkside and High Street Wimbledon in both directions.

## RIDE-SHARING APPS DROP-OFF

Ride-sharing apps must use the designated drop-off areas located on Marryat Road and Victoria Drive. Please note that cars from ride sharing apps, such as Uber or Bolt, cannot pass through the Church Road closure.





## PRIVATE TAXI OR CHAUFFEUR CAR DROP-OFF

- In the morning all private taxis and chauffeur cars should approach the site from the south (from Wimbledon).
- Please request a digital Temporary Access Pass from the AA in advance to gain access through the road closure for drop-off at the Guest Arrival Hub in Car Park 5.
- This will be emailed to you and must be shown on arrival to allow the vehicle past the road closure and directly to the Guest Arrival Hub.
- Please note this pass does not entitle the holder to park. Once drop-off has taken place, the driver must exit by Car Park 8, north on to Church Road.

## MOBILITY ASSISTANCE DROP-OFF

A drop-off point is available opposite Gate 13 on Somerset Road for Blue Badge holders.

If you would like to be dropped off nearer the debenture entrance at Gate 4, please request a Temporary Access Pass (as above). You can then use the buggy shuttle service operating from Car Park 5 to transport you to Gate 4.

## CAR SERVICE

Gerrard Cars offers a service for debenture holders who wish to arrange transport to and from The Championships.

The drop-off and pick-up location is at the Guest Arrival Hub in Car Park 5.





## PARKING AT THE GROUNDS

- Car Park 5 is available for registered debenture holders.
- Car Park 6 is available for all ticket holders and should be pre-booked [here](#).
- Minibus parking is available in Car Parks 1 and 6.
- Motorcycle parking is available in Car Park 6.

Bookings can be made in the run up to, and throughout The Championships, by calling the AA Wimbledon Parking booking line on **0330 041 3677**. Booking lines are open Monday to Friday 9am - 5pm until 28 June and then from 8am - 6pm every day during The Championships.

Due to the temporary closure of Church Road, please follow the signposted routes that correspond to the colour of your parking pass rather than relying on sat nav directions. Car Parks 5 and 6 have red passes.

## BLUE BADGE PARKING

- An area within Car Park 5 is available for registered debenture holders with Blue Badges.
- An area within Car Park 6 is available for all other Blue Badge holders.

## ACCESSING THE GROUNDS FROM THE CAR PARKS

There is a very short walk from Car Park 5, which takes you past the Guest Arrival Hub, for use by debenture and hospitality ticket holders, then across Church Road to Gate 4.

From Car Park 6 follow the signs to Church Road, then to Gate 4.

## LEAVING THE GROUNDS

For Wimbledon or the south, exit via Gate 12 on Somerset Road for:

- Shuttle bus to Wimbledon Station (leaves from Car Park 1).
- Shared taxi service.
- 20 minute walk to Wimbledon Station.

For Southfields or central London exit via Gate 1 on Church Road for:

- Taxis (located on Wimbledon Park Road).
- 15 minute walk to Southfields Station.

## Ride-sharing taxis pick-up

The pick-up points are located on Marryat Road and Wimbledon Park Road (opposite the taxi rank). Please note that cars from ride sharing apps, such as Uber or Bolt, cannot pass through the Church Road closure.

## Taxi pick-up

Shared taxi services with fixed fares operate from Southfields Station (return taxis to Southfields and central London from Wimbledon Park Road – exit via Gate 1) and Wimbledon Station (return from Somerset Road rank – exit via Gate 12).

## Private taxis or chauffeur pick-up

- The pick-up point is the Guest Arrival Hub at Car Park 5.
- **Please note**, collection access to Car Park 5 for private taxis and chauffeur cars opens from 3.30pm and access is via the entrance to Car Park 8 on Church Road (accessed from the north via Wimbledon Park Road). Drivers will need to display their Temporary Access Pass to gain entry.

# AT THE CHAMPIONSHIPS

## CAN I MEET FRIENDS OR FAMILY BEFORE ENTERING THE GROUNDS?

There is a Guest Arrival Hub for the use of debenture and No.1 Court hospitality guests. Inside there is a small amount of seating and toilets. It is a great place to wait for guests who are joining you for the day.

Debenture Hosts will be available here to answer any questions you may have.

The Guest Arrival Hub is located through the walkway opposite Gate 4, which is the gate we encourage all debenture ticket holders to use to enter the Grounds. View the map [here](#).



## ONCE IN THE GROUNDS HOW DO I ACCESS THE DEBENTURE AREAS?

To gain access to the debenture areas within Centre Court and No.1 Court, please show your mobile ticket. Debenture information lanyards will be provided at the entry points to the facilities upon displaying your ticket. Spot checks of mobile tickets will remain in place throughout the day.

## WHERE CAN I FIND INFORMATION ONCE I'M IN THE GROUNDS?

Our team of Debenture Hosts, dressed in Ralph Lauren uniforms and wearing name badges, will be on hand to assist you throughout the day.

Hosts are located at the Debenture Information Point to the left of the Fred Perry statue, which is visible once you enter Gate 4, and throughout the debenture areas. The Debenture Information Point is open from 10am – 2pm each day.







## WHERE ARE THE CLOAKROOMS IN THE DEBENTURE AREAS?

- The Centre Court cloakroom is located inside the ground floor Fred Perry entrance.
- The No.1 Court cloakrooms are located inside the ground floor of The Renshaw restaurant and at the debenture reception next to The Veranda restaurant entrance.
- Please bring any items you need with you in a bag measuring no more than 40cm x 30cm x 30cm.

## NEW FOR 2024

Each year we strive to improve the experience on offer at The Championships for all our guests. There are several changes in place around the Grounds this year. These include:

### On Court

Reflecting the continued growth of wheelchair tennis and its increasing popularity at Wimbledon, the Ladies' and Gentlemen's Wheelchair singles and doubles draws will be doubled this year. The singles competitions will increase from an 8 to 16 player draw, and the doubles competitions will increase from 4 to 8 teams. The increase in draw size means the Wheelchair Tennis competition will begin one day earlier, on Tuesday 9 July.

### Off Court

We have moved our Ticket Resale to a new location – further south towards the Media Pavilion, but still on the iconic Hill Lawn.

Our flagship Wimbledon Shop, located at the south-west corner of No.1 Court, has been fully refurbished and will open its doors for the first time at The Championships 2024. The new store will showcase the Wimbledon Collection in its entirety. With a wide variety of clothing across both performance and lifestyle, the range is suitable for both the court and the Clubhouse. The No.1 Court Shop will also house our fine bone china and kitchen textile ranges, drinkware, souvenir and gifting items, rackets, bags, publications and much more.

For the first time, guests will also have the opportunity to order personalised towels and baseball caps from our Personalisation Zone. Our Customer Service team will guide guests through the ordering process with personalised items then dispatched for delivery direct to the home. The No.1 Court Shop and other major stores will be open during The Championships from 10am - 10pm.





## Environmental Sustainability

We remain firmly committed to achieving our 2030 Environment Positive goal and have introduced initiatives this year to enhance our guest experience.

Throughout the Grounds, all our food menus will highlight the lower CO2 dishes available, indicating those with emissions below 290g per kilogram. Dishes are rated on an A to E scale, with A indicating very low. A QR code provides a link to more detail for guests seeking further information.

We want to make it easier for our guests to make informed choices when they visit Wimbledon, as well as giving us the

opportunity to track and ultimately reduce emissions associated with the food we prepare and serve.

Alongside evian, our Official Water Partner for the last 15 years, we are continuing our sustainability work by expanding the successful pilot of evian natural mineral water refills on court. This solution hydrated players and encouraged refillable behaviour at The Championships in 2023. For 2024, we will expand our pilot programme to include offering guests the ability to purchase and enjoy chilled evian natural mineral water refills at The Championships.

## WHAT FOOD & DRINK IS INCLUDED WITH MY DEBENTURE TICKET?

Debenture tickets provide you with access to a seat on Centre Court or No.1 Court, and the debenture areas.

There are a range of restaurants and bars available where you can enjoy a variety of food and drink from within the Centre Court and No.1 Court debenture areas.

## CAN I MAKE A RESTAURANT RESERVATION?

Advance reservations for our fine dining restaurants, The Champions' Room, Courtside Restaurant and The Renshaw (at No.1 Court) can only be made by registered debenture holders.

There may be some last-minute availability on the day, so please speak with the team at the Debenture Information Point next to the Fred Perry statue upon arrival.





## WHAT ARE MY OPTIONS IF I DON'T HAVE A RESERVATION?

## CAN I WATCH THE TENNIS FROM INSIDE THE RESTAURANTS AND BARS?

You will be able to see matches played on Courts 14 - 17 from a number of the restaurants and bars, however you will not be able to view play on Centre Court or No.1 Court.

## DO YOU CATER FOR SPECIAL DIETARY REQUIREMENTS?

Our menus include a selection of vegetarian, plant-based and NGCI options.

All menus have a QR code detailing ingredients and allergens.

- Reservations are required and can only be made in advance by registered debenture holders.
- If you have a reservation, all guests in your party must have a debenture ticket for Centre Court.

- Please access the restaurant via the Centre Court debenture entrance located between Courts 15 and 16.
- Please provide your booking name to our host team upon arrival at the restaurant entrance.

### What is included?

- Your table is reserved for the day and includes welcome drinks, a four-course lunch and traditional Wimbledon Afternoon Tea.
- Specially selected wines and a complimentary bar are also included.

### What time does my experience begin?

## THE RENSHAW - No.1 COURT

### Do I need to make a reservation?

- Yes, a reservation is required and can only be made in advance by registered debenture holders.
- If you have a reservation, all guests in your party must have a debenture ticket for Centre Court or No.1 Court.

### How do I access this restaurant?

- Please access the restaurant via The Renshaw entrance located near to Courts 15 and 16.
- Please provide your booking name to our host team upon arrival at the restaurant entrance.

### What is included?

- Your table is reserved for the day and includes a welcome glass of Pimm's No.1 cup or Lanson Black Label Brut NV, a three-course lunch and traditional Wimbledon Afternoon Tea.

### What time does my experience begin?

- The Renshaw opens at 10.30am.
- You will be given an arrival time on your reservation. To ensure you and your guests are able to enjoy the full day's experience, please arrive as close to your reservation time as possible.

## COURTSIDE RESTAURANT - CENTRE COURT

### Do I need to make a reservation?

- Reservations are strongly recommended for lunch and can only be made in advance by registered debenture holders.
- If you have a reservation, all guests in your party must have a debenture ticket for Centre Court.
- Whilst we cannot guarantee availability on the day, walk-ins are accepted.
- If you have a lunch reservation and would like to return for afternoon tea, we are unable to guarantee that we will be able to seat you in the same location.

### How do I access this restaurant?

- Please access the restaurant via the Centre Court debenture entrance located between Courts 15 and 16.
- Please provide your booking name to our host team upon arrival at the restaurant entrance.

### What is included?

- The Courtside Restaurant offers a three-course fixed price lunch menu.
- Wimbledon Afternoon Tea is served in the afternoon and charged separately.

### What time does my experience begin?

- The Courtside Restaurant opens at 10.30am.
- You will be given an arrival time on your reservation and to ensure you and your guests are able to enjoy your lunch at a leisurely pace, please arrive as close to your reservation time as possible.
- Wimbledon Afternoon Tea is served from 3pm.

## COURTSIDE BRASSERIE - CENTRE COURT

- Casual no-reservations restaurant, guests are seated on a first come, first served basis.
- Serves an all-day two or three-course menu.
- Open from 10.30am with last orders at 7.30pm.
- Busiest times are between 11am – 1.30pm.
- At busy times reservations are limited to 90 minutes.
- Please access the restaurant via the Centre Court debenture entrance located behind the Fred Perry statue, opposite Gate 4. View the location [here](#).

## THE TERRACE - CENTRE COURT

- Self-service restaurant with a separate bar and balcony seating overlooking the Tea Lawn.
- Serves light refreshments from 10am and lunch from 10.30am – 3pm.
- Savoury and sweet afternoon tea selection from 3.30pm until close.
- Light supper menu available in the evenings from 6pm with last orders at 9pm.
- At busy times our hosts will assist with seating, and we recommend arriving early for lunch.
- Please access the restaurant via the Centre Court debenture entrance located behind the Fred Perry statue, opposite Gate 4. View the location [here](#).

## THE GALLERY - CENTRE COURT

- A large bar offering a full range of drinks alongside a snack menu, overlooking Courts 14 to 17.
- Open from 10am, serving alcohol from 11am.
- Last drink orders at 9.30pm or 30 minutes after the last ball on Centre Court, whichever is earlier.
- Features a separate Lavazza coffee bar, serving a selection of morning pastries from 10am. The Lavazza coffee bar closes at 8pm.
- Please access The Gallery via the Centre Court debenture entrance located behind the Fred Perry statue, opposite Gate 4. Alternatively take the two flights of stairs from the Centre Court debenture entrance located between Courts 15 and 16. View the location [here](#).

## THE ROOF TOP - CENTRE COURT

- Outdoor terrace bar offering a full range of drinks as well as a selection of sandwiches, small plates and snacks.

## THE VERANDA - No.1 COURT

- Casual no-reservations restaurant, guests are seated on a first come, first served basis.

- Open from 10.30am with last orders at 7.30pm.
- At busy times (generally between 11am – 1.30pm), tables are limited to 90 minutes.

- Self-service restaurant, with floor to ceiling windows and great views across Courts 14 – 17.
- Serves light refreshments from 10am and lunch from 10.30am - 3pm.

- Light supper menu is available in the evenings from 6pm with last orders at 9pm.
- At busy times our hosts will assist with seating, and we recommend arriving early for lunch.
- Access the restaurant via the No.1 Court main debenture entrance.
