



BEFORE YOU VISIT

IS THERE A DRESS CODE?

Many of our guests choose to dress up for a day at Wimbledon, although there is no requirement for men to wear a jacket or tie in the debenture restaurants.

Please ensure you dress comfortably and are prepared for the British weather, whether that be rain or very warm sunshine.

WHAT SIZE BAG CAN I BRING WITH ME?

Pack everything you need in one bag per person measuring no larger than 40cm x 30cm x 30cm.

If your luggage is larger than this, it will need to be stored at one of our three left luggage locations outside the main Grounds. Find out more [here](#).

WHICH GATE SHOULD I ARRIVE AT?

All debenture ticket holders are encouraged to use Gate 4 on Church Road.

WHAT DOES MY DEBENTURE TICKET INCLUDE?

Debenture tickets are for the court specified on the date shown and entitle the ticket holder to entrance to that court and not to view a particular match, round of matches or individual players. Matches may move from one court to another at the discretion of the AELTC. See full terms and conditions [here](#).

You may also watch matches on any court throughout the Grounds with unreserved seating.

As well as Centre Court and No.1 Court, No.2 Court has reserved seating. You can watch matches in unreserved seats on No.3 Court, Court 12 and Court 18. Outside courts 4-11 and 14-17 all have unreserved seating.

To watch your favourite players practising, visit the viewing platform next to the practice courts in **Aorangi**.

Your Centre Court debenture ticket includes access to the Centre Court debenture bars and restaurants and The Renshaw restaurant located in No.1 Court (by reservation only).

Your No.1 Court debenture ticket includes access to the No.1 Court debenture bars and restaurants.


DO YOU TAKE CASH?

This is a cashless event, so please bring your credit/debit card or other form of cashless payment.

YOUR TICKETS

- Have your mobile ticket ready in the Wimbledon App along with photo ID for entry.
- The QR code on your mobile ticket will be active from 7am on the morning of the day you are attending.

HOW DO I ACCESS MY TICKET ON MY PHONE?



WHERE DO I GO IF I HAVE ISSUES WITH MY TICKET UPON ARRIVAL?

Please head to the Ticket Resolution Point at Gate 3 on Church Road if you have any issues with your debenture tickets.

WHERE ARE MY SEATS?

Debenture seats are located in rows A-N on Centre Court and rows A-Q on No.1 Court.

Your seat details will include a seat number, a row and a gangway. The gangway denotes the stairwell that you need to use to enter the court.

CAN I BRING CHILDREN?

Children aged five or older are welcome, provided they are always accompanied by an adult and have their own seat ticket.

Whilst we don't recommend bringing babies and infants, a ticket is not required for those under five. However, children under five are not allowed into the Show Courts (Centre Court, No.1 Court, No.2 Court, No.3 Court, Court 12 and Court 18).



TRAVEL

The main road outside the Grounds, Church Road, remains partially closed for the duration of The Championships to enhance the arrival experience for all our guests.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

The Championships Journey Planner is the best way to plan your trip. The planner highlights the most sustainable options for travelling to and from Wimbledon.

- 🚇 **Southfields Station** (District Line)
- 15 minute walk to the Grounds.
- 🚕 **Taxis** for the Grounds depart from the rank in Augustus Road adjacent to the station and drop off inside Car Park 8.
- 🚇 **Wimbledon Station** (District Line/South Western Railway/London Trams)
- 20 minute walk to the Grounds.
- 🚕 **Taxis** depart for the Grounds from the rank outside the main entrance to the station and drop off at Marryat Road, near the intersection with Somerset Road, close to Gates 12 and 13.
- 🚇 **Wimbledon Park Station** (District Line)
- 25 minute walk to the Grounds.

- 🚌 A dedicated Championships bus service runs from Wimbledon Station to the Grounds.
 - Single fare £4.00
 - Return fare £6.50

Return buses leave from Car Park 1 on Somerset Road.

Please note that the 493 TfL bus service is redirected during The Championships via Bathgate Road, Queensmere Road, Parkside and High Street Wimbledon in both directions.

RIDE-SHARING APPS DROP-OFF

Ride-sharing apps must use the designated drop-off areas located on Marryat Road and Wimbledon Park Road. Please note that cars from ride-sharing apps, such as Uber or Bolt, cannot pass through the Church Road closure.





PRIVATE TAXI OR CHAUFFEUR CAR DROP-OFF

- In the morning all private taxis and chauffeur cars should approach the site from the south (from Wimbledon).
- Please request a digital Temporary Access Pass from the AA in advance to gain access through the Church Road partial closure, to be dropped off near the Debenture Entrance at Gate 4 (via Car Park 5).
- The Temporary Access Pass will be emailed to you in late June and must be shown on arrival to allow the vehicle past the road closure and directly to the Guest Arrival Hub.
- Please note, this pass does not entitle the holder to park. Once drop-off has taken place, the driver must exit by Car Park 8, north on to Church Road.

REQUESTING A TEMPORARY ACCESS PASS

- 3 List your debenture tickets in the body of the email quoting the row, seat number(s) and Indexname.

MOBILITY ASSISTANCE DROP-OFF

A drop-off point is available opposite Gate 13 on Somerset Road for Blue Badge holders.

If you would like to be dropped off nearer the debenture entrance at Gate 4, please request a Temporary Access Pass (as above). You can then use the buggy shuttle service operating from Car Park 5 to transport you to opposite Gate 4.

CAR SERVICE

Gerrard Cars offers a service for debenture holders who wish to arrange transport to and from The Championships.

The drop-off and pick-up location is at the Guest Arrival Hub in Car Park 5.





PARKING AT THE GROUNDS

- Car Park 5 is available for registered debenture holders and must be pre-booked.
- Car Park 6 is available for all ticket holders and must be pre-booked [here](#).
- Limited minibus parking is available in Car Park 6 and must be pre-booked [here](#).
- Motorcycle parking is available in Car Park 6.

Bookings can be made in the run-up to, and throughout The Championships, by calling the AA Wimbledon Parking booking line on **0330 041 3677**. Booking lines are open Monday to Friday 9am - 5pm until 27 June and then from 8am - 6pm every day during The Championships.

Due to the temporary closure of Church Road, please follow the signposted routes that correspond to the colour of your parking pass rather than relying on sat nav directions. Car Parks 5 and 6 have white passes with a red circle showing the number.

BLUE BADGE PARKING

- An area within Car Park 5 is available for registered debenture holders with Blue Badges.
- An area within Car Park 6 is available for all other Blue Badge holders.

ACCESSING THE GROUNDS FROM THE CAR PARKS

There is a very short walk from Car Park 5, which takes you past the Guest Arrival Hub, for use by debenture and hospitality ticket holders, then across Church Road to Gate 4.

From Car Park 6 follow the signs to the Grounds and Gate 4.

LEAVING THE GROUNDS

For Wimbledon or the south, exit via Gate 12 on Somerset Road for:

- Shuttle bus to Wimbledon Station (leaves from Car Park 1).
- Shared taxi service.
- 20 minute walk to Wimbledon Station.

For Southfields or central London exit via Gate 1 on Church Road for:

- Shared taxi service (located on Wimbledon Park Road).
- 15 minute walk to Southfields Station.

Ride-sharing taxis pick-up

The pick-up points are located on Marryat Road and Wimbledon Park Road (opposite the taxi rank). Please note that cars from ride sharing apps, such as Uber or Bolt, cannot pass through the Church Road closure.

Taxi pick-up

Shared taxi services with fixed fares operate from Southfields Station (return taxis to Southfields and central London from Wimbledon Park Road - exit via Gate 1) and Wimbledon Station (return from Somerset Road rank - exit via Gate 12).

Private taxis or chauffeur pick-up

- The pick-up point is the Guest Arrival Hub at Car Park 5.
- Collection access to Car Park 5 for private taxis and chauffeur cars opens from 3.30pm and access is through Car Park 8 via the Wimbledon Park Road Entrance from the north only. The exit is onto Church Road and cars can only turn left towards Wimbledon Village. Drivers will need to display their Temporary Access Pass to gain entry - **please note**, access prior to 6.00pm is for immediate collection & departure - waiting is not permitted until after 6.00pm.





AT THE CHAMPIONSHIPS

CAN I MEET FRIENDS OR FAMILY BEFORE ENTERING THE GROUNDS?

There is a Guest Arrival Hub for the use of debenture and No.1 Court hospitality guests.

There is a small amount of seating outside and there are toilets inside. It is a good location to arrange to meet guests who are joining you for the day.

Debenture hosts will be available here to answer any questions you may have.

The Guest Arrival Hub is located through the walkway opposite Gate 4, which is the gate we encourage all debenture ticket holders to use to enter the Grounds. View the map [here](#).



ONCE IN THE GROUNDS HOW DO I ACCESS THE DEBENTURE AREAS?

To gain access to the debenture areas within Centre Court and No.1 Court, please show your mobile ticket. Tickets will be scanned and you will be given a wristband to wear for the day. **We strongly advise you to collect your wristband upon arrival and before taking your seat to watch the tennis.**

WHERE CAN I FIND INFORMATION ONCE I'M IN THE GROUNDS?

Our team of debenture hosts, dressed in Ralph Lauren uniforms and wearing name badges, will be on hand to assist you throughout the day.

Hosts are located at the Debenture Information Point to the left of the Fred Perry statue, which is visible once you enter Gate 4, and throughout the debenture areas. The Debenture Information Point is open from 10am – 2pm each day.





WHERE ARE THE CLOAKROOMS IN THE DEBENTURE AREAS?

- The Centre Court cloakroom is located inside the ground floor Fred Perry entrance.
- The No.1 Court cloakrooms are located inside the ground floor of The Renshaw restaurant and at the debenture reception next to The Veranda restaurant entrance.
- Please bring any items you need with you in a bag measuring no more than 40cm x 30cm x 30cm.

NEW FOR 2025

Each year we strive to improve the experience on offer at The Championships for all our guests. There are several changes in place around the Grounds this year. These include:

On court

The provisional schedule for The Championships Finals Weekend has been adjusted, with the gentlemen's and ladies' doubles finals to commence at 1pm, followed by the ladies' and gentlemen's singles finals at 4pm, on the second Saturday and Sunday respectively.

Live Electronic Line Calling (Live ELC) has been adopted for this year's Championships and onwards. The officiating technology will be in place across all Championships and Qualifying match courts and cover the 'out' and 'fault' calls that have previously been made by line umpires.

The decision to adopt Live ELC was made following the successful completion of extensive testing during last year's Championships and builds on the existing ball tracking and line calling technology that has been in place for many years.

Off court

The Cavendish opens as a new public restaurant for The Championships, with all-day dining options available within the heart of No.1 Court. Formerly Parkside Kitchen, the refurbished and renamed space will provide a dining experience that champions the best of British seasonal ingredients - whether guests are seeking a quick bite to eat in between matches, a relaxed lunch, or a traditional Wimbledon Afternoon Tea. The Cavendish is available for reservations in advance as well as walk-ins on the day.

As we seek to evolve our guest experience, we are introducing new technology in the Walled Garden Larder that removes the need to visit a till when purchasing food and drink items. This year, guests will tap their card upon entry to the store, select their items, then leave the Larder with the charge removed from their card as they depart. This innovation ensures guests spend less time queuing and more time enjoying the tennis.



Environmental sustainability

Wimbledon remains firmly committed to its 2030 Environment Positive goal. Our Official Water Partner for the last 16 years, evian, continues its commitment to reduce plastic packaging waste at The Championships and encourages spectators to join the refill and reuse movement. Look out for their refill stations around the Grounds and in debenture areas.

We have measured the carbon weightings of all the food we serve taking into consideration the entire life cycle of ingredients within each dish. This is illustrated using a simple rating scale of A (very low emission) to E (very high emission). We want to make it easier for our guests to make climate conscious choices when they visit, as well as giving our chefs the ability to track and ultimately reduce the emissions associated with the food we serve.




OPTIONS TO SUIT YOUR NEEDS THROUGHOUT THE DAY

Head to The Terrace in Centre Court or The Lounge in No.1 Court. Our self-service restaurants serve light refreshments from 10am including a selection of pastries and Wildfarmed bacon and egg rolls.

Head straight to the Lavazza coffee bar located in The Gallery in Centre Court or the No.1 Bar in No.1 Court. The Roof Top bar in Centre Court also serves speciality coffees.




Enjoy a sit-down lunch before play starts.

The Courtside Brasserie in Centre Court and The Veranda in No.1 Court offer all-day menus. Equally, our self-service restaurants The Terrace in Centre Court, or The Lounge in No.1 Court, offer a wide range of hot and cold options until 3pm.



Champagne and strawberries to take back to court.


If you're looking for both, we suggest heading to The Terrace in Centre Court and The Lounge in No.1 Court. For takeaway drinks you can head to any of our bars.



Time for a cup of tea and some scones or cake.


A selection of cakes, scones with Wimbledon jam and Cornish clotted cream, tea and filter coffee are available in The Terrace in Centre Court and The Lounge in No.1 Court from 3.30pm. (On Finals weekend from 3pm in The Terrace.)

Walk-ins are accepted for sit-down afternoon tea in the Courtside Restaurant, subject to availability. Service begins at 3pm with last orders at 4.30pm. On Finals weekend service begins at 2.30pm with last orders at 4pm.



Pick up some takeaway options for the break in play.

Our range of Wimbledon sandwiches and salad boxes can be found in The Terrace in Centre Court and The Lounge in No.1 Court. A smaller range is available from our bars along with a selection of snacks.



Enjoy the atmosphere and stay late for the tennis.

Light supper menus are available from 4.30pm with last orders at 9pm in The Terrace in Centre Court and The Lounge in No.1 Court.

Our all-day menus in the Courtside Brasserie in Centre Court and The Veranda in No.1 Court have last orders at 7.30pm.



I have a special occasion to celebrate and I'd like to reserve a table at a restaurant.

Our fine dining restaurants, The Champions' Room and Courtside Restaurant in Centre Court, and The Renshaw in No.1 Court all require advanced reservations.

Reservations can only be made by registered debenture holders, although there may be some last-minute availability on the day. Please speak with the team at the Debenture Information Point next to the Fred Perry statue upon arrival to enquire about availability.

There are also plenty of other food & drink options around the Grounds at The Championships.

Can I watch tennis from inside the restaurants and bars?

You will be able to see matches played on Courts 14-17 from a number of restaurants and bars, however you will not be able to view play on Centre Court or No.1 Court.



Courtside Brasserie - Centre Court



- Guests are seated on a first come, first served basis.
- All-day two or three-course menu.
- Open from 10.30am with last orders at 7.30pm.
- Busiest times are between 11am - 1.30pm.
- At busy times sittings are limited to 90 minutes.
- Take the stairs or lifts from the Centre Court debenture entrance located behind the Fred Perry statue, opposite Gate 4. View the location [here](#).

The Terrace - Centre Court



- Self-service restaurant with a separate bar and balcony seating overlooking the Tea Lawn.
- Serves light refreshments from 10am and lunch from 10.30am - 3pm.
- Savoury and sweet afternoon tea selection from 3.30pm until close.
- Light supper menu available from 4.30pm with last orders at 9pm.
- At busy times our hosts will assist with seating, and we recommend arriving early for lunch.
- Take the stairs or lift from the Centre Court debenture entrance located behind the Fred Perry statue, opposite Gate 4. View the location [here](#).

The Gallery - Centre Court



- Indoor bar with a terrace overlooking Courts 14 to 17, also offering a snack menu.
- Open from 10am, serving alcohol from 11am.
- Last drink orders at 9.30pm or 30 minutes after the last ball on Centre Court, whichever is earlier.
- Features a separate Lavazza coffee bar serving a selection of morning pastries from 10am. The Lavazza coffee bar closes at 8pm.
- Take the stairs or lift from the Centre Court debenture entrance located behind the Fred Perry statue, opposite Gate 4. Alternatively, take the two flights of stairs from the Centre Court debenture entrance located between Courts 15 and 16. View the location [here](#).

- Outdoor terrace bar also offering a selection of sandwiches, small plates and snacks.
- Lavazza coffees and speciality teas are also served.
- Open from 10am with service from 10.30am and last orders at 7.30pm.
- Please note this is a very popular space and for your enjoyment, we may limit the number of guests on The Roof Top terrace at busy times.




The Veranda - No.1 Court

- Open from 10.30am with last orders at 7.30pm.
- Busiest times are between 11am - 1.30pm.
- At busy times sittings are limited to 90 minutes.

No.1 Lounge – No.1 Court




- Self-service restaurant with floor-to-ceiling windows and great views across Courts 14 – 17.

- At busy times our hosts will assist with seating, and we recommend arriving early for lunch.

Do I need to make a reservation?

- Reservations are required and can only be made in advance by registered debenture holders.
- If you have a reservation, all guests in your party must have a debenture ticket for Centre Court.

How do I access this restaurant?

- Access the restaurant via the Centre Court debenture entrance located between Courts 15 and 16.
- Please provide your booking name to our host team upon arrival at the restaurant entrance.

What is included?

- Your table is reserved for the day and includes welcome drinks, a four-course lunch and traditional Wimbledon afternoon tea.
- Specially selected wines and a complimentary bar are also included.

What time does my experience begin?

- The Champions' Room opens at 10.30am.
- All guests are encouraged to be on Centre Court when play starts, so please arrive in good time to enjoy the full day's experience.

Courtside Restaurant - Centre Court

Do I need to make a reservation?

- Reservations are strongly recommended for lunch and can only be made in advance by registered debenture holders.
- If you have a reservation, all guests in your party must have a debenture ticket for Centre Court.
- Whilst we cannot guarantee availability on the day, walk-ins are accepted.
- If you have a lunch reservation and would like to return for afternoon tea, we are unable to guarantee a table in the same location.

How do I access this restaurant?

- Access the restaurant via the Centre Court debenture entrance located between Courts 15 and 16.
- Please provide your booking name to our host team upon arrival at the restaurant entrance.

What is included?

- The Courtside Restaurant offers a three-course fixed-price lunch menu.
- Wimbledon afternoon tea is served in the afternoon and charged separately.

What time does my experience begin?

- The Courtside Restaurant opens at 10.30am.
