



WHITE CLOTHING RULE 2023

THE RULE DEFINED

- The White Clothing Rule refers to all clothing, including tracksuits and sweaters, worn on the courts for both practice and matches.
- Competitors must be dressed in suitable tennis attire that is almost entirely white – there should be no solid mass or panel of colouring other than females' dark undershorts should they choose to wear them. This applies from the point at which the player enters the court surround.
- The rule has introduced an exemption for female players who are allowed to wear solid, mid/dark-coloured undershorts provided they are no longer than their shorts or skirt.
