Turning to our plans to transform the former Wimbledon Park Golf Course, as you may have read before Christmas, at the Greater London Authority's public hearing in September 2024, the possibility of a statutory trust on the land was raised in their officers' report. Our position was and remains that there is not, nor has there ever been, a statutory trust affecting the golf course. As we have advised previously, in the current circumstances we recognise that the correct

thing to do, at this stage, is to put the matter before the court for a decision. If you have not ticked these boxes, we will not be able to email you information about the community ticketing scheme.
