



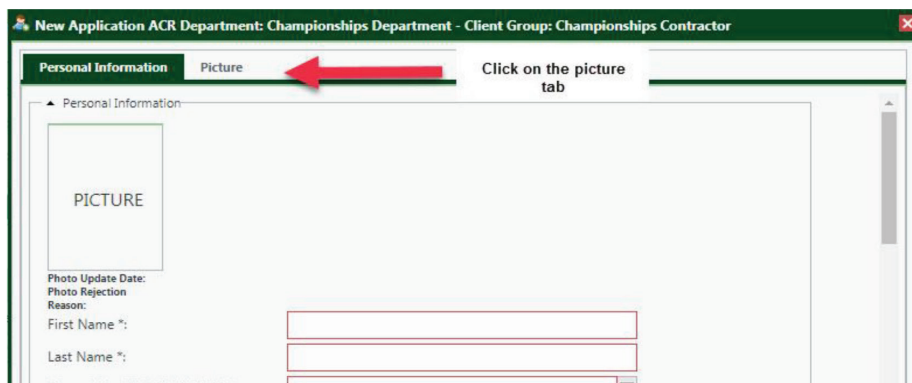

SUBMITTING PHOTOGRAPHS FOR CHAMPIONSHIPS ACCREDITATION

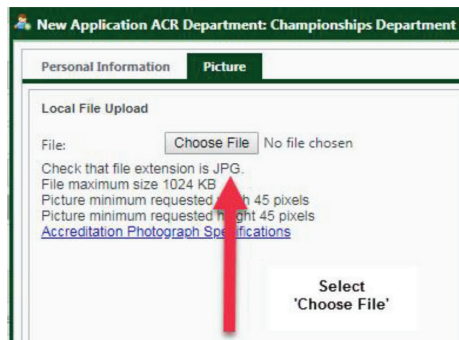
UPLOAD A NEW PHOTOGRAPH

You can add photographs to new or existing applications.

1. Click on the picture tab in the application form window.

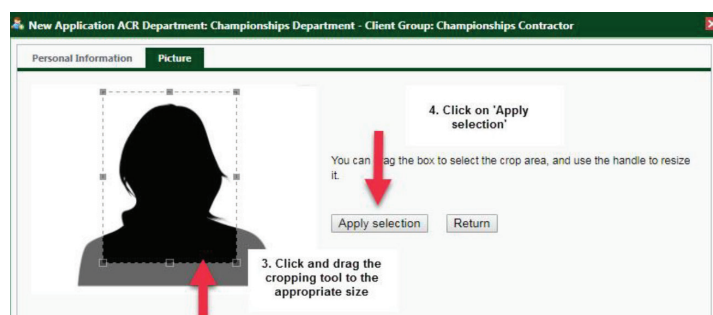


2. Select the 'Choose File' option to browse your computer for the photograph.



3. Click and drag the cropping tool to the correct area of the photograph.

4. To save the photograph, click 'Apply selection'.



5. Click on the 'OK' button to save and close the application.

You may submit applications but add a picture later (prior to the 31 May deadline). You are strongly advised to submit photographs with all applications to allow passes to be pre-printed. If you are unable to submit a photograph, the applicant can attend the accreditation perimeter office to have a photograph taken during The Championships.

Accreditation photographs will be used for up to three years for returning applicants.

PHOTOGRAPH STATUSES

You will be able to see the status of an applicant's photograph on the right-hand side of the search results.

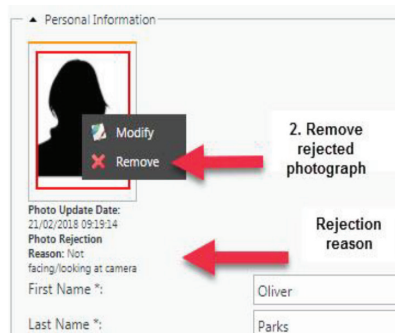

REPLACE REJECTED PHOTOGRAPHS

If a photograph is rejected, you can remove and replace it.

1. Open the record with the rejected photograph and review the rejection reason.
2. Right click on the photograph and select 'Remove'
3. Add a new photograph via the picture tab (see upload a new photograph section).

ACCREDITATION PHOTOGRAPH SPECIFICATIONS

The photograph provided for your accreditation must meet specific criteria. The photograph must be:

- A true likeness of you and of your full head
- In colour, not black and white, against a plain light grey or cream background
- Clear, in sharp focus, free from 'red eye' with no shadow
- Free of any reflection or glare from glasses
- No less than 133 x 100 resolution, and ideally 531 x 398 resolution
- In JPEG format, with a file size no larger than 500KB.

You must:

- Face forward and look straight into the camera with your eyes open and nothing covering your face
- Have nothing covering your eyes e.g. hair or glasses frame
- Not wear sunglasses or tinted glasses
- Not wear a hat or cover your head unless for medical or religious reasons
