BEFORE YOU VISIT

DRESS CODE

The dress code is smart casual in all hospitality areas. If you have any questions about the dress code, we encourage you to contact your Suite Host.

TIMINGS

- 10am** ● The Grounds open daily
- 11am** ● Play begins on outside courts
- 1pm** ● Play begins on No.1 Court (apart from Finals weekend when play starts at 11am)
- 1.30pm** ● Play begins on Centre Court (apart from Finals weekend when play starts at 2pm)
- 9pm** ● Suites close half an hour after close of play or 9pm, whichever is earlier. Your Suite Host will communicate these timings to you prior to the event

TICKETS

Your tickets will be accessible via the Wimbledon App so please install the latest version, download your ticket and bring photo ID with you for entry. If you are not receiving a digital ticket you will be given a paper ticket by your host on arrival.

Your ticket guarantees you entry to the Grounds on the date shown and to the court and seat on your ticket.

Your ticket does not guarantee that you will be able to watch any particular match, round of matches or individual players. Scheduling requirements may mean that matches occasionally move from one court to another.

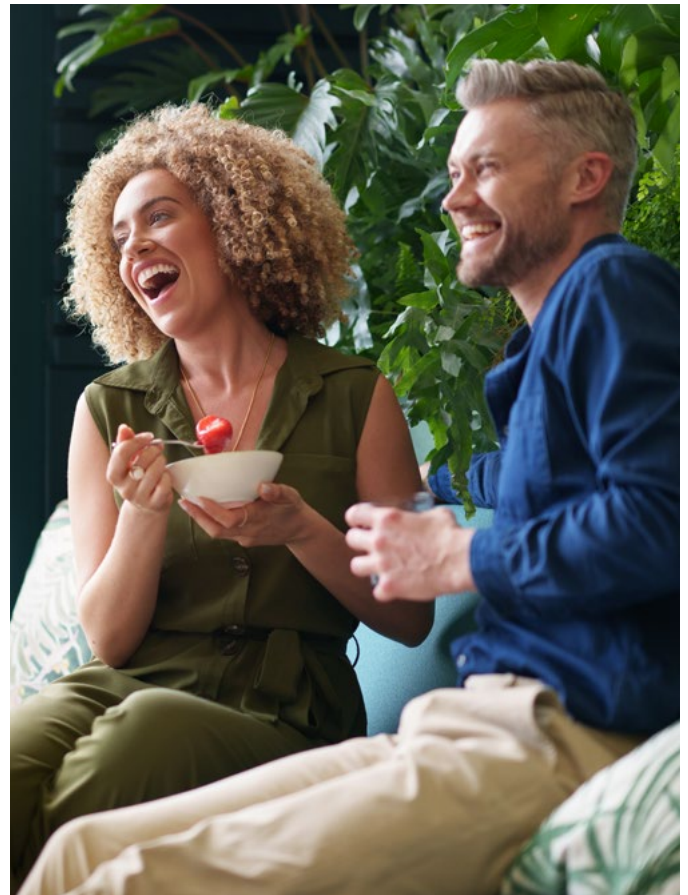

TICKET CONDITIONS

Tickets are issued subject to the **Terms and Conditions of Sale**.

Tickets with the word 'DEBENTURE' marked on them in place of the price may be legally transferred or sold on.

Do not buy tickets from touts or other unauthorised agents; they will not gain you entry to the Grounds.

Please do not post pictures of your ticket offer or tickets on any social media channel or website. The details may be used to defraud third parties into buying them.

ARRIVAL

If you are a No.1 Court hospitality guest and have been advised to go to the Guest Arrival Hub to collect lanyards or tickets, this is located through the walkway opposite Gate 4. If you are coming from Car Park 5 you can follow the signage. Once inside the hub, please head towards the desk displaying your host's company logo. From there you will be directed towards your suite in No.1 Court.

For any guests going to a Centre Court suite, your Arrival Hubs are located in Car Park 6.

Please help our staff at the gates by having your bag ready to be searched. There may be a short wait while we assist your arrival;

we appreciate your patience and cooperation while we complete our vital security checks.

The safety of all our guests at The Championships is paramount. We will have security measures in place that are visible - such as our team of friendly search dogs - and some that are behind-the-scenes. But everyone has a role to play in the safe delivery of The Championships.

Help us protect you by reporting anything that does not feel right to a member of Security, one of our Guest Services team, or your Suite Host. We will always act on your concerns.

WHAT TO BRING

Pack everything you need in one bag per person measuring no larger than 40cm x 30cm x 30cm. Please familiarise yourself with the list of items that aren't allowed inside the Grounds [here](#).



CHILDREN

- Please note that a ticket is not required for children under the age of five and they are welcome to enjoy the activities around the Grounds. However, they are not allowed into Show Courts (Centre Court, No.1 Court, No.2 Court, No.3 Court, Court 12 and Court 18) and due to building regulations are not allowed in the No.1 Court suites.
- Children over five and under the age of 16 require their own ticket and are allowed into all courts accompanied by an adult. They are also welcome in the suites, however please be mindful that the hospitality area is a business environment for professional networking.

ACCESSIBILITY

We endeavour to provide a high standard of accessible services and facilities for guests with disabilities and are constantly working to improve their Championships experience. The Accessibility page on our [website](http://wimbledon.com) provides an overview of all services and facilities we have available. The Accessibility Guide is available to download and there are printed copies available around the Grounds. We also have large print versions available.

TOILETS

There are many accessible toilets around the Grounds and within the hospitality areas in Centre Court and No.1 Court, as well as two Changing Places toilets – see the [Grounds Map](#) for locations.

To use our accessible toilets you will need a RADAR key. These are available free of charge from every entrance gate, our Information Points or via our Hospitality Hosts located at the Guest Arrival Hub, Gate 4 and the reception areas in No.1 Court.

WHEELCHAIR & MOBILITY AIDS

We have designated areas to leave your mobility scooter or wheelchair. See the [Grounds Map](#) for locations.

Please note that neither the AELTC nor St John Ambulance provides wheelchairs for guests.

SUNFLOWER LANYARD

At Wimbledon we understand that not all disabilities are visible, and our staff recognise that those wearing a sunflower lanyard may need additional assistance or support during their visit. Sunflower lanyards are available from the Accessibility Services kiosk on the Southern Concourse.



TRAVEL

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

The Championships Journey Planner is the best way to plan your trip. The planner highlights the most sustainable options for travelling to and from Wimbledon.

-  Southfields Station (District Line) - 15 minute walk to the Grounds.
-  Wimbledon Station (District Line/South Western Railway/London Trams) - 20 minute walk to the Grounds.
-  Wimbledon Park Station (District Line) - 25 minute walk to the Grounds.
-  A dedicated Championships bus service runs from Wimbledon Station to the Grounds.

- Single fare £4.00
- Return fare £6.00

Return buses leave from Car Park 1 on Somerset Road.

Please note that the 493 TfL bus service is redirected during The Championships via Bathgate Road, Queensmere Road, Parkside and High Street Wimbledon in both directions.

PARK & RIDE

A Championships Park and Ride service is available at Morden Park (located on the A24, postcode SM4 5QU) charged at £15 per car or minibus.

This is open from 6.30am - 11pm, with the last bus leaving the AELTC at 10pm, or at 10.40pm if there is late play on Centre Court or No.1 Court.

Pre-booking is possible but not required.

TAXI & DROP-OFF

- Shared taxi services with fixed fares operate from Southfields Station (return taxis to Southfields and central London from Wimbledon Park Road – exit via Gate 1) and Wimbledon Station (return from Somerset Road rank – exit via Gate 12).
- Drop-off and pick-up areas for pre-booked taxis are marked on the **Hospitality Arrival & Departure Map**.
- Please note that ride sharing apps e.g. Uber and Bolt, will not be able to pass through the Church Road closure. They must use the designated drop-off areas marked on the **Walking to The Championships Map**.



CYCLING

Bicycle parking (including hire bicycles) is situated in Car Parks 6 and 10 and is free of charge. Bicycles left at other locations may be removed. All bicycles are left at the owner's risk.

CAR

- Please note that Church Road is closed between 9am - 11.30pm and only vehicles with access passes will be granted entry.
- In the morning all cars should approach the site from the south (from Wimbledon).
- For those who do not have a parking pass but are arriving by private taxi or chauffeur car, please request a digital drop-off access pass from your Suite Host. This will be emailed to you and can then be shown on arrival to gain entry.
- Please note, if you have a pre-paid parking pass, you can continue straight on to Car Park 5.
- Please follow signed routes to car parks, rather than sat nav directions in order to avoid delays.
- The Guest Arrival Hub is within the AELTC Wimbledon Park area adjacent to Gate 4 where guests can collect their suite lanyard or tickets if applicable (unless you are a Centre Court Suite guest in which case this will be located in Car Park 6). Guests can also return here at the end of the day to be picked up.
- If you already have your lanyard, you can follow the signs to your suite from Car Park 5.
- Please contact your Suite Host in advance to request parking.
- Please note that vehicle access to Car Park 5 changes after 3.30pm. Vehicles coming to pick-up will need to enter via Car Park 8 (accessed from the north via Wimbledon Park Road) and follow the signs to Car Park 5. Guests going to a Centre Court suite will need to go to Gate 5.



ARRIVAL AT THE GATES

- From the Guest Arrival Hub, signage and hosts will direct you, on foot, to Gate 4.
- AELTC Hosts will be stationed between the Guest Arrival Hub and the gates to help with directions or answer any questions.
- Buggies will be available for guests with mobility requirements.
- There will be a Ticket Resolution point located at Gates 3 and 5.
- Please be prepared to have your bag searched on entry to the Grounds.
- You will not be permitted to take in any **prohibited items**.

LEAVING THE GROUNDS

For Wimbledon or the south, exit Gate 12 on Somerset Road for:

- Shuttle bus to Wimbledon Station (leaves from Car Park 1).
- Shared taxi service.
- 20 minute walk to Wimbledon Station.

For Southfields or central London exit via Gate 1 on Church Road for:

- Taxis (located on Wimbledon Park Road).
- 15 minute walk to Southfields Station.

If you are being collected by private hire or chauffeur car, please return to the Arrival Hub located in Car Park 5.

WALKING TO THE CHAMPIONSHIPS MAP



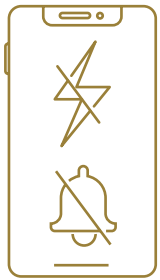

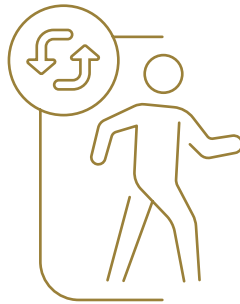

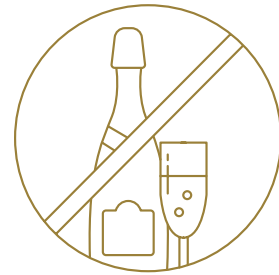

NEW FOR 2024

Each year we strive to improve the experience on offer at The Championships for all our guests. There are several changes in place around the Grounds this year. These include:

On court

Reflecting the continued growth of wheelchair tennis and its increasing popularity at Wimbledon, the Ladies' and Gentlemen's Wheelchair singles and doubles draws will be doubled this year. The singles competitions will increase from an 8 to 16 player draw, and the doubles competitions will increase from 4 to 8 teams. The increase in draw size means the Wheelchair Tennis competition will begin one day earlier, on Tuesday 9 July.

Off court

We have added a Queue Welcome and Queue Village as additional areas for guests to enjoy on their Queue journey and have moved our Ticket Resale to a new location – further south towards the Media Pavilion, but still on the iconic Hill Lawn.

Our flagship Wimbledon Shop, located at the south-west corner of No.1 Court, has been fully refurbished and will open its doors for the first time at The Championships 2024. The new store is 25 per cent larger and will showcase the Wimbledon Collection in its entirety: apparel collections cover lifestyle and fashion with clothing and accessories and performance ranges suitable for the court to the Clubhouse. The No.1 Court will also house our fine bone china and kitchen textile ranges, drinkware, souvenir and gifting items, rackets, bags, publications and much more. For the first time, guests will also have the opportunity to order personalised towels and baseball caps from our Personalisation Zone. Our Customer Service team will guide guests through the ordering process with personalised items then dispatched for delivery direct to the home. The No.1 Court Shop and other major stores will be open during The Championships from 10am - 10pm.

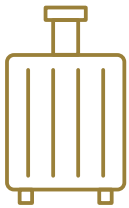
First Aid & Pharmacy

Hosts

Hosts will be stationed along the guest journey from the Guest Arrival Hub, through Gate 4 and to the suites. Suite Hosts will be located at reception desks at the top of each entrance staircase within No.1 Court to answer any questions.



Left Luggage

Located within the Guest Arrival Hub. Please note that bags deposited should be no larger than 60cm x 45cm x 25cm/24" x 18" x 10" (aircraft cabin size). This facility is free of charge and all bags will be searched before being accepted into the left luggage facilities.

Smoking

Smoking (including vaping) is not permitted on courts, in buildings, in any queue or on The Hill. When smoking, please be considerate of other guests.



Ticket Resale, proudly supported by Barclays

Subject to availability, after 3pm you may purchase returned Show Court tickets from the Ticket Resale Kiosk north of Court 18. Tickets cost £15 for Centre Court and £10 for No.1 Court and No.2 Court. All proceeds go to the Wimbledon Foundation.

Please keep hydrated and refill your bottle for free at bottle refill points throughout the Grounds.



Wi-Fi

Free Wi-Fi is available in all suites. After connecting to 'Wimbledon Guest Wi-Fi' you will be prompted to enter your details and will then be connected.

Free Wi-Fi is also available on The Hill and along the east side of the Grounds including Parkside and the Tea Lawn.
