MEMBERS' GUEST GUIDE

Monday 3 - Sunday 16 July 2023

This guide will give you all the information you need to plan your visit and ensure you have a wonderful day at Wimbledon. Please read it carefully and pay particular attention to the Dress Code section. Further information on The Championships can be found on Wimbledon.com and via the official Wimbledon App.

ACCESS TO THE GROUNDS

You will need a Court Ticket or Grounds Pass to enter the Grounds during The Championships and can enter via Gate 5 or Gate 13 which are for Members and Members' guests. Please look out for the Member Services Team who will be dressed in Ralph Lauren and able to assist and point you in the right direction.

TICKETS

Members will provide their guests with tickets in either mobile or paper format. If you have a mobile ticket, please remember to download the Wimbledon App or update it to the latest version.

This year Members and their guests will be able to swap their tickets via the Wimbledon App once inside the Grounds.

Please do not share or post pictures of your tickets on any social media platforms or websites.

TICKET COLLECTION

Members' guest ticket collection is located at the Indoor Tennis Centre reception, opposite Gate 13. You will need photo ID to collect your ticket and can only collect on the day you are attending The Championships.

TIMINGS

- 10am The Grounds open The Members' Lawn and Members' Brasserie open
- 11am Play begins on outside courts The Members' Restaurant opens
- 1pm Play begins on No.1 Court (apart from Finals Weekend when play starts at 11am)
- 1.30pm Play begins on Centre Court (apart from Finals Weekend when play starts at 2pm)
- Afternoon tea is served 2pm
- 6pm The Members' Restaurant closes
- 8pm The Members' Brasserie closes
- The Members' Lawn closes 9pm

SECURITY

Comprehensive security measures will be in place for all those visiting The Championships including random security checks and searches.

Pack everything you need in a single bag measuring no more than 40cm x 30cm x 30cm and visit wimbledon.com or scan the QR code below to familiarise yourself with the list of prohibited items.



TRAVEL Public transport

Please use the TfL Journey Planner to choose the best mode of transport.

- Southfields Station (District Line) a 15 minute walk to the Grounds.
- Wimbledon Station (District Line/South θ
- ⋧ Western Railway/London Trams) a 20 minute walk to the Grounds.
- θ Wimbledon Park Station (District Line) a 25 minute walk to the Grounds.
- There is a dedicated Championships bus service from Wimbledon Station to and from the Grounds. Single fare £3.80, return fare £5.90. Return buses leave from outside Gate 11 on Somerset Road (exit the Grounds through Gates 12 or 13).

Please note the 493 TfL bus service does not stop outside the Grounds during The Championships.

Cycling

Bicycle parking is available in Car Park 6 and 10 and is free of charge.

Car

There is no specific Members' guest parking available. Public car parking is available in Car Park 6 (pre-booked or on-day) or Car Park 10 (pre-booked only). For further details visit wimbledon.com or scan the QR code below.



If you do choose to drive, please use postcode SW19 5AG to reach us via sat nav or other mapping services.

Taxis & drop-off

Taxi ranks are situated at Southfields and Wimbledon Stations, and a shuttle service operates from the taxi rank opposite Gate 4, situated in Wimbledon Park for Southfields and the North, and from Somerset Road (Gate 12) for Wimbledon and the South, as well as services to all other destinations.

Drop-off and pick-up for taxis is located at the bottom of Marryat Road.

Blue Badge drop-off points are available opposite Gate 13 on Somerset Road.

MEMBERS' ENCLOSURE

If you have been invited by a Member into the Members' Enclosure, please meet the Member and enter together. If your host is not present, guests with Centre Court and No.1 Court tickets are able to access the Members' Enclosure, but only after 1.30pm.

Dress code



The dress standards in the Members' Enclosure will be strictly enforced and the Club reserves the right to refuse entry to any person considered unsuitably dressed. Please ensure your attire is appropriate as outlined below. Gentlemen are reminded that ties are required in the Members' Enclosure.

There should be no changing of clothing upon entering or exiting the Members' Enclosure, particularly in the foyer area.

Suitable dress

- The dress standard for gentlemen is a lounge suit or tailored jacket, shirt, tie and trousers.
- Ties are required whilst in the Members' Enclosure.
- Ladies are expected to dress to a similar standard and are encouraged to dress in smart daywear. They may wear jumpsuits

(ankle-length) and trouser suits if they Smart, open-toe shoes are also welcom

- Shoes must be clean and smart; sports including tennis and running shoes will be permitted.
- National costume and religious requirements such as a clerical collar are acceptable.

Unsuitable dress

Guests are asked to refrain from wearing:

- T-shirts, bare midriffs, jeans or denim of any type or colour (including white), shorts, leggings, playsuits, miniskirts, zipper jackets and hoodies.
- Sports shoes including tennis and running shoes, flip flops or sandals.
- Dresses and skirts should be of modest length, defined as falling just above the knee or longer.

DRESS CODE FOR CHILDREN

- Children are expected to meet a similar standard of dress when entering the Members' Enclosure.
- Boys aged 11 and under are not required to wear a jacket or tie but must wear a collared shirt (this may be short-sleeved) and dress trousers.
- Girls are asked to dress to a similar standard.
- Children are also asked not to wear denim. sports shoes or flip-flops.
- School uniform is permitted.

Located at Gate 4, open daily until 10pm (or 30 minutes after end of play). Free of charge to all guests during The Championships.

Wi-Fi Free

Complimentary wifi is available on The Hill and along the east side of the Grounds including Parkside and the Tea Lawn.
