
BEFORE YOU VISIT





TICKETS

Your tickets will be accessible via the Wimbledon App so please install the latest version, download your ticket and bring photo ID with you for entry.



Your ticket guarantees you entry to the Grounds on the date shown and, if applicable, to the court and seat on your ticket. Your ticket does not guarantee that you will be able to watch any particular match, round of matches or individual players. Scheduling requirements may mean that matches occasionally move from one court to another.

TICKET CONDITIONS

Tickets are issued subject to the **Terms and** Conditions of Sale. Please pay particular attention to clauses: 13 (Use of Tickets), 17 (Refunds), 18 (Curtailment of Play), 19 (Liability) and 20 (Force Majeure).

REFUND/NON-TRANSFER POLICY

If you cannot use your tickets, please visit the **Help Centre** here on further information on how to request a refund. If you purchased your tickets through the LTA, contact the LTA Customer Support Team to request a refund through their online form, making sure you include your order number. Tickets are strictly non-transferable.

CURTAILMENT OF PLAY

If there is a curtailment of play, you may be entitled to a refund of some, or all, of your ticket price depending upon the Referee's record of how much play takes place on your ticketed court.

Toilets

There are many accessible toilets around the Grounds, as well as two Changing Places toilets – see the **Grounds Map** for locations.

To use our accessible toilets, you will need a RADAR key. These are available free of charge from every entrance gate or our Information Desks.



Wheelchair & Mobility Aids

We have designated areas to leave your mobility scooter or wheelchair. See the **map** for locations. Please note that neither the AELTC nor St John Ambulance provide wheelchairs for visitors.

Court Seating for Wheelchair Users

Centre Court, No.1 Court, No.2 Court and No.3 Court have reserved wheelchair seating for ticket holders; there are also unreserved spaces available for wheelchair users on all outside courts.

Sunflower Lanyard

At Wimbledon we understand that not all disabilities are visible, and our staff recognise that those wearing a sunflower lanyard may need additional assistance or support during their visit. Sunflower lanyards are available from the Accessibility Services Point on the Southern Concourse.





TRAVEL

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Please use the **TfL Journey Planner** to choose the best mode of transport.

- Southfields Station (District Line) a 15 minute walk to the Grounds.
- → Wimbledon Station (District Line /→ South Western Railway / London Trams) -a 20 minute walk to the Grounds.
- Wimbledon Park Station (District Line) a 25 minute walk to the Grounds.
- A dedicated Championships bus service runs from Wimbledon Station to and from the Grounds. Single fare £3.80, return fare £5.90. Return buses leave from outside Gate 11a on Somerset Road.

Please note the 493 TfL bus service does not stop outside the Grounds during The Championships.

CYCLING

Bicycle parking is situated in Car Parks 6 and 10 and is free of charge. Bicycles left at other locations may be removed. All bicycles are left at the owner's risk.

PARKING

- Reserved parking is available via The AA in advance in Car Parks 6 and 10 £40 petrol/diesel cars or £20 electric vehicles.
 Book here.
- Pay on the day, subject to availability, in Car Park 6 - £40 petrol/diesel cars or £20 electric vehicles.
- Blue badge parking is located in Car Parks 6 and 8 £3 (admin charge).
- Motorcycles Car Park 4 £10.
- Please note, a section of Church Road between Gate 1 and Gate 5 will be closed from 9am - 11.30pm during The Championships.
- Please follow signed routes to car parks, rather than sat nav in order to avoid delays.

PARK & RIDE

A Championships Park & Ride service is available at Morden Park (located on the A24, postcode SM4 5QU) charged at £15 per car and £20 for minibuses. This is open from 6.30am - 11pm, with the last bus leaving the AELTC at 10pm, or at 10.40pm if there is late play on Centre Court or No.1 Court. Pre-booking is **not** required.





TAXIS

Taxi ranks are situated at Southfields and Wimbledon Stations, and on Church Road (across from Gate 4, situated in Wimbledon Park) and Somerset Road (Gate 12). See our designated drop-off and pick-up areas for pre-booked taxi services on the Walking to The Championships Map.

ARRIVAL AT THE GATES

- On arrival at the gate please have your ticket ready to be scanned along with accompanying photo ID.
- Please be prepared to have your bag searched on entry to the Grounds.
- You will not be permitted to take in any prohibited items.

LEAVING THE GROUNDS

For Wimbledon or the south, exit via Gates 11a or 12 on Somerset Road for:

- Shuttle bus to Wimbledon Station.
- Taxis.
- 20 minute walk to Wimbledon Station.

For Southfields or Central London exit via Gates 1 or 4 on Church Road for:

- Taxis (located opposite Gate 4).
- 15 minute walk to Southfields Station.

AT THE CHAMPIONSHIPS

NEW FOR 2023

Each year we strive to improve the experience on offer at The Championships for all our guests. There are several changes in place around the Grounds this year. These include:

On Court

In discussion around how best to support women and girls competing at The Championships we have changed our white clothing rule. Female competitors are now able to wear mid/dark-coloured undershorts if they choose to do so.

The Gentlemen's Doubles format has been shortened from best-of-five sets to best-of-three bringing Wimbledon into line with the other Grand Slams.

Alongside the other Grand Slams and the Tours, Wimbledon will participate in a one-year trial of off-court coaching.

Environmental Sustainability

Our commitment to becoming Environment Positive by 2030 remains in sight and we have introduced a number of initiatives this year to help us reach this goal.

The most noticeable Environment Positive change will be on court. Working alongside evian, our Official Partner for the last 15 years, we are pleased to confirm the next step in our sustainability journey together is the pilot of an on-court refillable water solution, which will offer pure evian water for the players. We will be providing players with reusable bottles that they can refill during their time at The Championships.

Throughout the Grounds, all our food menus will highlight the low CO2 dishes available, with emissions below 500g per portion. A QR code provides a link to more detail for guests seeking further information.

We want to make it easier for our guests to make informed choices when they visit Wimbledon, all the while tracking and reducing emissions associated with the food we prepare and serve.

Southern Village

A series of enhancements have been made in the Southern Village - the section of the grounds running between No.2 Court and the Rosewater Pavilion.

These include a large screen set up showing live tennis with deck chairs, weather shade and an improved food and drink offering alongside our exciting partner activation spaces. Find out more **here**.


A new entry gate (Gate 11a) will be opened in this space to ease the flow of guests into the Grounds.


Our Food Markets, Larders and Bars offer a variety of on-the-go choices for a quick snack between matches.

TICKETS

- Children under the age of five do not require a ticket.
- Children over the age of five and under 16 require a ticket.
- Children under 16 must always be accompanied by an adult.

WATCHING TENNIS

Children under the age of five are not allowed on the Show Courts (Centre Court, No.1 Court, No.2 Court, No.3 Court, Court 12 and Court 18). However, there are nine remaining courts around the Grounds which everyone can enjoy. Families with young children can also watch the live action from the Show Courts on the big screen on The Hill or in the Southern Village.

USEFUL INFORMATION

- We understand that sometimes crowds can be overwhelming for families, so we have a small Family Room in Wimbledon Park opposite Gate 4, available to those who would benefit from a quiet environment.
- Other quieter, more sheltered parts of the site include Parkside and Southern Village.

- Guests are welcome to bring their own food and drink to Wimbledon, but please note that hard-sided containers, vacuum flasks over 500ml and items such as picnic hampers and cool boxes are prohibited.
- Guests are welcome to bring buggies and pushchairs.
- Baby changing facilities are available throughout the Grounds.
- Our visitors are welcome to breastfeed anywhere onsite.
- Accessible toilets and Changing Places facilities can be accessed using a RADAR key. These are available at any entrance gate and Information Points.
- For further information about access, please refer to Accessibility at The Championships. Alternatively, Information Points are located around the Grounds if you need assistance on the day.
- There is an onsite Pharmacy, located in the Parkside zone on the east side of No.1 Court.



Information Points

Guest Services Team members are located throughout the Grounds and will be happy to answer any questions.





We have three left luggage locations:

- Wimbledon Park, servicing the Queue, open from 6am.
- AELTC Wimbledon Park, open from 7.30am.
- Somerset Road, open from 9am.

All left luggage locations close one hour after the end of play. Items are charged at £1 each for all bags and £5 for larger items. Please note that bags deposited should be no bigger than $60 \text{cm} \times 45 \text{cm} \times 25 \text{cm}/24$ " x 18" x 10" (aircraft cabin size).
