



INTRODUCTION

For 2021, accredited personnel have been grouped into three tiers. This has been done for the following reasons:

- To (along with accreditation access codes) give a visual indication of what areas people are primarily based in
- To indicate which personnel should / should not have prolonged contact with certain groups
- To inform what level of testing is required for individuals.

Tier Definitions

Tier 1

This tier includes the following:

- All Players
- Player Guests
- Designated staff who are integral to the tournament in a player focussed role, have access to player restricted areas at the tournament venue and hotel, and have daily regular in-person contact with players and their guests (for more than 15 minutes a day).

Tier 1 individuals will receive an RFID sticker on their accreditation which will allow their movements within player areas to be tracked through the PMY track and trace system. This is a numbered sticker on the accreditation which must not be removed.

Tier 1 individuals must:

- Remain within the Minimised Risk Environment (official hotel and designated areas within official venues) at all times with the exception of some medical staff as agreed with the CMO who will undergo daily testing should they need to leave and re-enter the hotel.
- Only utilise official transport to move between the official hotel and official venues.
- Receive a negative PCR test on arrival at the hotel before their accreditation will be validated.
- Be part of the Cignpost testing regime.
- Complete a daily health questionnaire.
- Avoid prolonged contact with Tier 2, avoid any contact with Tier 3 individuals and not access non-restricted areas frequented by Tier 3 individuals.
- Maintain Social Distancing and follow all COVID protocols outlined in the playbook at all times.

Tier 2

This tier includes designated individuals where contact with players or access to player areas is required or possible as part of their role, but contact is minimal and/or risk mitigation methods are in place.

Examples of groups within this tier include Officials, Drivers, Security and F&D staff within player areas, AELTC Staff, Committee and Contractors that are required to enter player areas.

These individuals are not designated to be in the Official Player Hotel but may be staying in another hotel OR in privately arranged accommodation.

Tier 2 individuals will receive an RFID sticker on their accreditation which will allow their movements within player areas to be tracked through the PMY track and trace system. This is a numbered sticker on the accreditation which must not be removed.

Tier 2 individuals must:

- Avoid regular and prolonged contact with anyone within Tier 1 unless adequate mitigation is in place (eg screening, ventilation, face coverings).
- Only enter player areas to carry out work, and depart as soon as their work is complete.
- Utilise the government twice weekly LFD testing scheme throughout their employment for The Championships and carry out their first test prior to commencing their Championships employment.
- Maintain Social Distancing and follow all COVID protocols outlined in the playbook at all times.

Tier 3

This tier includes individuals who perform essential tournament services but do not require close contact with Tier 1.

Examples of groups in this tier include: Security and F&D staff in non-player areas, Stewards, Retail Teams, AELTC Staff and Contractors who are not required to enter player areas.

Tier 3 individuals must:

- Avoid any contact with Tier 1 at all times.
- Minimise contact with Tier 2.
- Utilise the government twice weekly LFD testing scheme throughout their employment for The Championships and carry out their first test prior to commencing their Championships employment.
- Maintain Social Distancing and follow all COVID protocols outlined in the playbook at all times.

Tier 3 individuals will not have an RFID sticker on their accreditation, and so will not be traceable through the PMY Track and Trace System covering player areas.

Testing

Tier 1 (and Officials)

Tier 1 individuals will be part of the Minimised Risk Environment testing regime operated by Cignpost Diagnostics.

Those (aged 4 years and over) arriving into the Minimised Risk Environment from the UK, Green or Amber Countries will receive the following tests during their time at The Championships:

Day	Test
0	PCR
2	Administered LFT
5	Administered LFT
8	PCR
Every 4 days after	Administered LFT

Those entering the Minimised Risk Environment from a Red Country will be subject to the following:

Day	Test
0	PCR
1-3	Administered LFT
4	PCR
5	Administered LFT
8	PCR
Every 4 days after	Administered LFT

Tier 1 individuals will be required to register with an online platform prior to arrival which will then generate their testing profile and provide reminders for tests due.

As part of the testing software, all Tier 1 individuals will also be required to complete a Daily Health Questionnaire. They will be unable to leave the hotel to board official transport if this has not been completed.

Tier 2 and Tier 3

Everyone in Tier 2 (excluding Officials) and Tier 3 should use the Government twice-weekly lateral flow device (LFT) testing scheme and report the results directly into the government website. LFT test kits can be ordered to your home address or collected from your local pharmacy, and everyone should ensure they carry out their first test in advance of commencing their work at The Championships or before players arrive on-site (whichever is earlier).

Those in Tier 2 / 3 who have been granted an Elite Sport Exemption to enter the UK are responsible for arranging and paying for their own Day 2 / 8 Entry and must follow the additional restrictions in place for their 'quarantine' period.

Some groups within Tier 2 (those primarily working in player areas) will be required to show their Line Manager proof of negative test results twice a week.

For all other individuals, spot checks will be carried out to ensure compliance.
