Day 1 at Wimbledon brought us sun and showers..today brings us even more stars

Elena Rybakina starts her title defence... she's already reached the final of the Australian Open this year> She won't want to relinsh the venus roswter dish.

She lost that final to Arnya Sabalenka...who followed up the win in Melbourne by reaching the last four at Roland Garros. She's firmly among the favourites.

She's one of the most charismatic players on the tour, can last year's finalist Ons Jabeur win her first Grand Slam. A quater finalist at Rland Garros she's a name tyo keep an eye on.

Carlos Alcaraz is the man of the moment. He arrives at Wimbledon fresh from winning the warm up event at Queens. The World number one looking to add the Wimbledon crown to last year's US Open/

Another US Open winner on court today is Danill Medvedev... he's never been beyond the Fourth round on grass though. The third seed will be one to watch here.

Stafanos Tsitipspias has the tools to do well at Wimbledon. He's got a tricky opening opening match though. The 5th seed is up against a man who's has a grand slam to his name in Austria's Dominic Thiem.

And they'll be plenty of support for the British favourite Andy Murray...the two time champion has been in form on the grass and is one of only two players in the mens draw to have lifted the trophy.

Denmark's Holger Rune among the early arrivals at Wimbledon today. He may be the 6th seed but this is actually only his second time at the All England Club. Reports in the build up of a back problem so we shall see how he goes.

Matteo Berrettini is another one who's fitness has been under scrutiny in the build up to Wimbledon. The 27 years old Italian got to the final here in 2021 but has been struggling with injury this year. He missed the French Open and then lost in the first round at Stuttgart on his comeback. He's due to play another Italian today in Lorenzo Songeo.

Stefanos Tsitsipas has twice reached grand slam finals but his record at Wimbledon is modest. He got to the fourth round in 2018 before losing to John Isner. And it was Nick Kyrios who beat him last year in the third round. The 5th seed will be desperate to make an impact here.

With Emma Radacanu sidelined British hopes in the women's draw rest on the shoulders of Katie Boulter. The 26 year old is in fine form having won the recent warm up event in Nottingham last month. She'll also draw confidence from her performance here last year when she beat former finalist Ka Pliskova on centre court.

Easy to forget Carlos Alcaraz is world number one given the star that is Novak Djokovic. He's just 20 but a lot of pressure on his shoulders to live up to the hype swirling around him.

Maria Sackari one to watch here. The 27 year old from Greece is the 8th seed and twice a grand slam semi finalist. Will be very keen to improve on the 3rd round here which isn't her best at Wimbledon in 6 appearances.
